

16 Ship Pacific off Western Islands 1851.

121. Thursday June 19th Commenced with calm and pleasant & 4 p.m. Boarded with the Brig Harbinger Hunt Tercera dist 12 Miles Middle and Latter Parts light breezes & A.W. daylight the Lance dist 15 Miles. The Brig and 2 Sails in sight so ended.

122 Friday June 20th All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant. Boarded with Bark President and Brig Harbinger Cruising off and on the Island of Tercera in Company with 5 Sails.

123. Saturday June 21st All these 24 hours light airs and pleasant & 1 p.m. lowered the Boats for Black fish succeeded in taking 2 W.B.B. & 5 p.m. lowered again got 2 more so ended with pleasant weather Cruising off and on the Island also 6 Sails in sight.

124. Sunday June 22nd All these 24 hours light airs and pleasant the Bark Age's Boat Boarded us 3 months but nothing. 2 more Sails in sight Tercera dist 8 Miles & P.W. also St. George. Pico & Graciosa so ended with pleasant weather.

125. Monday June 23rd All these 24 hours light breezes and pleasant Boarded with the Brig Harbinger and 3 p.m. Bark President daylight commenced boiling out the Blackfish blubber Cruising off and on the Lance.

126 Tuesday June 24th All these 24 hours light airs & 2 p.m. lowered 3 Boats for Blackfish got nothing. 2 Bark's and the Brig in sight. William Gravel

127. Wednesday June 25th All these 24 hours Moderate breezes Cruising to the N.E. of the Island Tercera lowered a boat went in shore got 6 Ogy. MacKrel 4 Sails in sight.

128. Thursday June 26th Commenced with strong breezes & B.W. and hazy. Middle Part Moderate with rain Latter Part light breezes and fair headed in shore boarded the Ship Florida of Fairhaven 21 days out no oil. so ended.

129 Friday June 27th Moderate breezes and pleasant & 2 p.m. the Capt. of the Brig Harbinger came on board & heading in shore sunset headed off daylight the Lance to the N.W. dist 12 Miles also 3 Sails saw Blackfish lowered 3 Boats got 2 W.B.B. so ended.

130 Saturday June 28th Commenced with Fresh breezes & A.W. the Island of Tercera bearing N.W. dist 10 Miles daylight 3 Sails in sight also the Land so ended with hazy weather.

131 Sunday June 29th Commenced with light breezes and foggy. boiling out the Blackfish blubber sunset 4 Sails in sight headed off shore and light heading in shore also 4 Sails in sight & 11. Boarded with the Brig Harbinger so ended. *William Gravel*

132 Monday June 30th Commenced with Moderate breezes and pleasant in company with the Harbinger also 3 Sails in sight sunset kept off. Middle & Latter Part light breeze steering for St. George 3 Sails in sight. Tercera bearing N.W. dist 8 Miles.

133. Tuesday July 1st Commenced with light breezes and pleasant & 4 p.m. St. George bearing A.W. dist 5 Miles took to the E. exchanged signals with the Bark Draco of New Bedford 38 days out. Boarded with the Brig Harbinger & 8 Boarded with the Bark Draco of N. Middle Part standing off and on St. George. so ended.
