160 Sunday July 27th All these 24 hours Moderate breeze S. E. and pleasant steering S. S. W. the Ship in tight hands at leisure on this the Lord's day.
 Noon Lat^o 29.29 N Long 24.58 W.

161 Monday July 28th All these 24 hours Fresh Trades S. E. and pleasant steering S. S. W. p. 6 ship employed in ship's duty to land.
 Noon Lat^o 26.52 N Long 25.09 W.

162 Tuesday July 29th All these 24 hours Fresh S. E. Trades and fine weather nothing in sight.
 Noon Lat^o 23.54 N Long 25.24 W.

163 Wednesday July 30th All these 24 hours Fresh Trades and hazy steering S. by E. nothing in sight to land.

164 Thursday July 31st All these 24 hours Moderate N. E. Trades and hazy saw Blackfish one mile in sight.

165 Friday Aug 1st All these 24 hours Moderate breeze and hazy steering S. S. W. sunset here too with the foretold rain to the mast day light kept off S. by W. p 9 A.M. saw St. Antonio's bearing S. S. E. dist 20 Miles
 Noon Lat^o 17.12 N Long 25.23 W.

166 Saturday Aug 2nd Commenced with Light trades and pleasant lowered the boats for Black fish without success. Sunset the South part of St. Antonio bore S. E. by S. Latent Part Fresh trades steering S. by W.
 Noon Lat^o 15.23 N.

167 Sunday Aug 3rd Commenced with Light Trades and pleasant steering S. by W. p 3 P. M. saw the Land. Sunset the Island of Beara bore S. S. E. dist 10 Miles Moderate standing off and on daylight kept off for the Village p 8 A.M. the Boat left the ship for the shore p 11 the Boat returned to land.

168 Monday Aug 4th Commenced with Moderate Breeze and pleasant p 6 P. M. the Boat returned with logs, Bananas & Pine Apples spoke the Ship James Allen of N.B. Clean Moderate Part standing off and on p 7 the Boat left the ship for shore to land laying off and on the Island of Beara.

169 Tuesday Aug 5th Commenced with Light breeze and fair weather p 6 the Boat returned with logs & Bananas. Kept off S. by W. ship a Steward Middle & Latent parts the same the Ship James Allen in sight left John on shore.
 Noon Lat^o 13.54 N.

170 Wednesday Aug 6th Commenced with Light breeze and pleasant steering S. by W. 2 sails in sight also Black fish.
 Noon Lat^o 12.54 N Long

171 Thursday Aug 7th All these 24 hours Moderate breeze and variable with passing rain squales from N. W. to N. S. W.
 Noon Lat^o 10.51 N.
