186. Friday Aug²²^d All these 24 hours strong
S.E. trades steering to the S.
Noon Lat⁷ 24° S Long 21° 33'

187. Saturday Aug²³^d All these 24 hours strong
trades S.E. heading to the S. by the wind
Noon Lat⁹ 30° S

188. Sunday Aug²⁴^d All these 24 hours strong trades
from E.S.E. to S.E. and clear nothing in sight
Noon Lat¹¹ 45° S Long 22° 15'

189. Monday Aug²⁵^d All these 24 hours moderate
trades and fine weather heading by the wind from
S.W. to S. nothing in sight Noon Lat¹³ 21° S Long 22° 50'

190. Tuesday Aug²⁶^d All these 24 hours moderate
trades and pleasant weather heading by the
wind to S.W. saw a large sperm whale
going to the S.E. lowered 3 boats the Larboard Boat
struck him and drewed the Bow Boat struck
and drewed. the Waist Boat struck and drewed
then all the boats got fast to him again the
Waist Boat killed him sunset got him along
side Noon Lat¹⁵ 20° S Long 23°

191. Wednesday Aug²⁷^d Daylight commenced
cutting & 5 p.m. finished the body to ends laying
by the head.

192. Thursday Aug²⁸^d Daylight commenced
cutting off the bulk. Noon finished baling the
case to end with equally weather.

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193. Friday Aug²⁹^d Commenced baling the head
strong breezes and equally heading to the S.E. by the
wind on sail in sight Noon Lat¹⁴ 30° S

194. Saturday Aug³⁰^d Commenced with strong trades
and equally employed in baling — Noon Lat¹⁴ 50° S

195. Sunday Aug³¹^d Commenced with strong breezes
and equally & 4 p.m. finished baling daylight heading to the
South and made sail latter part equally with rain
Noon Lat¹⁵ 20° S Long 24° 20'

196. Monday Sept¹^d Commenced with strong breezes
and equally heading by the wind to the South.
nothing in sight Noon Lat¹⁵ 47° S Long 24° 07' W

197. Tuesday Sept²^d Commenced with fresh breezes S.E.
heading to the S. employed in ship's duty
Noon Lat¹⁷ 11° S Long 33°

198. Wednesday Sept³^d Commenced with light air inclining
to calm employed coopers and stowing down oil between
decks. Noon Lat¹⁸ 20° S

199. Thursday Sept⁴^d Commenced with light air and
calm stowing down between decks mixed part
moderate breeze S.W. with passing rain squalls latter part
strong breeze S.E. with rain heading to the S.E. by the wind.
Noon Sun Obs

200. Friday Sept⁵^d All these 24 hours strong breezes
and equally from N.W. to S.W. heading to the Eastward
nothing in sight Noon Lat¹⁸ 15° S Long 31° 44' W
