243 Saturday Oct 18th All these 24 hours Fresh breezes from N.W. to S. from S. to N.W. with foggy and rain squalls

244 Sunday Oct 19th First part of these 24 hours Strong breezes and foggy. 5 took in sail and hove too under spencers & fore top mast stay sail headed to the N.E. with a strong Gale from N.W. and passing thunder squalls day light moderating kept off E. S. E. under double reefed top sails. Now Lat 38.45 S. Long 62.08 E

245 Monday Oct 20th First part of these 24 hours Fresh breeze & N.W. and clear steering E. S. E. Middle part the same Later Part made all sail unless the fore sail to mend
