p 9 P.M. haul to the Eastward under close reef. Maintops
sail and spencers p 8 A.M. Kept off E.S.E. nothing in
sight Noon Lat 38. 37 S. Long 79. 50

256 Friday Nov 1st First Part of these 24 hours
Moderating. Made sail steering E.S.E. with the wind
to the N.W. Middle Part light airs from S.W. in-
clining to calm Later Part Calm.

257 Saturday Nov 2nd First Part light breezes
from N.W. heading E.S.E. Middle and Later
