

Ship Pacific Indian Ocean Nov. 1851.

274 Thursday 18th First Part of these 24 hours light breezes plenty of Right Whales in sight lowered 3 Boats struck and Kill one & sent him along side & commenced boiling & 6 commenced cutting noon finish Made sail headed to the S.E.

Noon Lat 40.18 S. Long 122.56 W.

275 Wednesday 19th Commenced clearing up decks and getting the works under weigh The Ship & Boats in sight boiling finbacks in sight to end with calm and on watch below

Noon Lat 40.00 S.

Thursday 20th Commenced with light wind and fine weather employed boiling Middle part the same day light saw Whales lowered 3 Boats struck and Kill one got him alongside and commenced cutting noon.

Lat 40.11 S.

277 Friday 21st Employ cutting & finish and commenced boiling Middle part strong breeze from the N. Latter Part the same employ boiling

Noon Lat 40.15 S.

278 Saturday Nov 22nd First Part of these 24 hours fresh breezes Middle part and Latter part strong Gale N. employ boiling.

279 Sunday Nov 23rd All these 24 hours strong Gale N. employ boiling

Noon Lat 40.33 S.

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280 Monday Nov 24th Commenced with strong breezes from N. to N.W. employ showing sail down the Main Stutchway

281 Tuesday Nov 25th All these 24 hours fresh Gale S. P. to N.W. with passing squalls employ showing down sail

282 Wednesday Nov 26th All these 24 hours strong gales from S. W. to N.W. laying too anchor Spencer and Foretopmast stay sails every man at his Post

Lat 40.30 S.

283 Thursday Nov 27th All these 24 hours strong gales laying too turned up the Waist Boats on the Chained the Harboard Boat over head at the watch at their Post

284 Friday Nov 28th All these 24 hours strong Gales from S. W. to N.W. laying too so ends the Mate showing off his bonnet in style

Noon Lat 41.09 S. Long 124.06 W.

285 Saturday Nov 29th First Part of these 24 hours Moderate Made sail headed to the N. broke the Ship & Mortejuma Capt. Power of Bedford 4 1/2 Months out Olean Latter Part fresh breezes & N. steering N.W.

286 Sunday Nov 30th First Part of these 24 hours strong breezes & N.W. Part off S. by S. Middle Part the same Latter Part strong breezes & S. W. took in sail.

Noon Lat 42.41 S. Long 129.35 W.
