

354. Friday July 6th First Part of these 24 hours light air headed to the S.W. out of the passage to take the trades to go to leeward of Eimeo at 4 PM took the trades steering down to the West Point of Eimeo & 10 haul by the wind N.E. Misadale Park spally with Thunder and lightning daylight Eimeo bore S.E. with 20 miles. Hahuta bore S.E. Later Part heading S.W. by the wind.

355. Saturday 7th First Part of these 24 hours light breeze and variable beating up to the harbour of Hahuta sunset the East Point of Eimeo bore S.W. Misadale Park the same day light saw the Harbour & Ships to Anchor one brig under sail coming out Later Part light air and pleasant.

356 Sunday 8th Standing in for the Harbour & the Pilot came on board & came to anchor in 15 fathoms Later Part more a ship up the harbour in 8 fathoms water sent one watch on shore on Liberty.

In Port

Employed in Painting Ship getting off wood and water and Sunaries other food. with one watch on shore on Liberty every day 6 men run away caught them again put them in Prison took them on board the day before we sail. The Abraham Barker of New Bedford 17 Months out. Whales the Ship America of MS 8 Months out. Sp Thursday July 28 getting ready for sea

374. Thursday July 25th at 10 The Pilot came on board got under weigh from the Pilot and Capt went on shore to Anchorage bore S.W. 2 miles. Laying off and on.

375. Friday 26th At 5 PM the Capt came on board headed to the Eimeo shore sail day light kept off to the westward Moon Eimeo bore S.E. dist 5 leagues

376. Saturday 27th Strong Trades & 3 PM saw sperm whales lowered the boats without success & 5 came on board standing there the night on shore tacked Eimeo bore S.E. dist 8 miles

377. Sunday 28th Strong trades & 1 saw sperm whales lowered the boats and boat struck got loose the waist Boat Miss & 5 the boats came on board standing off and on Eimeo till Monday March 1st kept off for Botabola Thursday 2nd made the Island the Capt went on shore trading for Hogs Banans for Potatoes Coconuts laying off and on getting of recruits of different descriptions till Sunday March 7th made sail for another small Island sent 2 boats ashore trading for Coconuts and the Hog Natives the 8th made sail headed to the N.E. with fresh breeze

Monday 8th Noon Lat 15.32 Long 150.58 W.

This day I alter this Journal 12 hours back from East Long to West which alters the day and day of the Month
