

Ship Pacific Arctic Ocean Aug 32

535 Sunday Aug 8th Commenced with light breezes and passing foggy squalls saw polar whales lowered the boats without success - the Whales very wild and hard luck

536 Monday Aug 9th All these 24 hours the boats chasing whales the Dow Boat struck horns broke the whale went to glory, hara, hara.

537 Tuesday Aug 10th First part of these 24 hours chasing whales the Larboon boat struck and dragged Latter Part more whales struck one the Dow Boat got Capsized lost one Man a Portuguese by name Jose Tomas by getting foul of the line the whale sounded took him down afterwards saved the body on the line

538 Wednesday Aug 11th First Part of these 24 hours the boat fast the whale spouting blood & 3 p.m. got him along & 4 p.m. hauled the Man and commenced cutting mid night finish Latter Part boiling and chasing whales

539 Thursday Aug 12th Employed boiling and chasing whales struck and dragged hara hara luck Latter Part finish boiling a great many ships and boats in sight my self sick with my Saw

540 Friday Aug 13th All these 24 hours chasing whales and boiling latter part finish boiling also a great many ships in sight

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541 Saturday Aug 14th Employed in chasing whales & 3 p.m. struck and killed one & 4 p.m. the whale along side commenced cutting

542 Sunday Aug 15th Employed cutting finish Latter Part commenced boiling and throwing down oil in the fore hold 32 Ships in sight

543 Monday Aug 16th Stop boiling the blubber most to green to boil Latter Part strong breeze & 10 Ships in sight

544 Tuesday Aug 17th Commenced with strong breezes and thick weather almost a gale of wind Latter part commenced boiling spoke the Ship Primrose of St. George 16 Mon the 8 o'clock no return

545 Wednesday Aug 18th All these 24 hours fresh breeze & employed boiling 14 ships in sight

546 Thursday Aug 19th All these 24 hours strong breezes & N. with sea, went snow squalls few to boiling and commenced throwing down oil in the fore hold

547 Friday Aug 20th All these 24 hours employed throwing down oil saw polar whales spoke the Ship Parachute of St. George 17 whales the season finish to throwing 20 ships in sight saw one take a whale along side

548 Saturday Aug 21th Light air with calm employed chasing whales 20 sails in sight some boiling cutting and chasing whales saw the Ship Parachute take one along side
