Wednesday 7th December.

Fine weather light wind and a heavy swell from the South saw three sails, stood down the whale which was about twenty barrels mending boat sails all hands employed in ship duty's. So ends this day.

Thursday 8th December.

Heavy and thick weather at two o'clock last night two of the men Forehead had a fight which one of them cut the other pretty bad. put him in iron in the main. All hands employed in ship duty's, so ends this day.

Friday 9th Dec.

Fine weather light wind saw plenty of spinn-bacns all day had a shell of worm on the boat sails at 3 a.m. raised a right whale of the weather beam worm ship up to the windward drop down the boats at five got pretty handy to them but they went so we come on board. so ends this day.

Lat: 34 ~~X~~ Long: 25.07.

Saturday Dec 10th

Thick weather and light winds this morning we saw fish of all kinds black fish and fillers and then we saw one right whale at sight board down but did not get any came on board when sun set in thick. This afternoon all well to day fill one hog today.

Sunday Dec 11th

Very thick weather the ship is under two reef topsail all day all well today.

Monday Dec 12th

Thick heavy weather the ship under two reef topsail plenty of finback in sight all well to day.

Tuesday Dec 13th

Fine weather all sail out at six pm tarb in the light sail being thick and fog at times all well to day.

Wednesday Dec: 14th

Strong wind today land in sight under short sails all day running off at sun set all well so ends this day.

Thursday Dec: 15th

Strong wind today short sail two sails in sight, we had a heavy fog and it lasted until one all hands employed in ship duty's, so ends this day.

Friday Dec: 16th

Light wind sometimes calm, all hands employed in ship duty's, so ends this day.

Saturday 17th Dec:

Thick, heavy weather, all sails out breaking out water and mending a new spanster, at night we kill one hog so ends this day.

Sunday Dec: 18th

Strong breeze sometimes falls at squall thick weather had a freshmes for dinner all hands employed in ship duty's. All right. So ends this day.

Monday Dec: 19th

Strong breeze light sails in all day bent a new spanster all hands employed in ship duty's so ends this day.
