

Monday 13th Feb.

This day commences with very heavy gail
wind hauled to the north westward set
the fore sail at ten ship heaving to berth
with ease very cold quite close at sunset
plenty of fimbals in sight all hands
employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Tuesday 14th Feb.

Very heavy weather ship under short sails wore
ship at daylight very cold at eleven run the
reefs out the maintopsail, all hands employed.

Wednesday 15th Feb.

Thick heavy weather ship under short sail very
cold wore ship at ten at four closed reefed
the topsail all hands employed in ship duty
so ends this day.

Thursday 16th Feb.

Strong breeze from the south very cold wore
ship at nine this morning broke out water
a ship under short sails all hands employed
in ship duty so ends this cold day.

Friday 17th Feb.

Thick heavy weather and fog ship under short
sails ^{plenty} of fimbals at ten kept ship off
south east shorten sails all day all hands
employed in ship duty so ends day.

Saturday 18th Feb.

Heavy rain all night at daylight wore in
the foretopsail wind still blowing on at
eight came on quite heavy gail from the
North West at nine raised the Bark
Stambole but did not speak to her on
account of bad weather at sun down wind
all gone so ends this day.

Sunday 19th Feb.

Light wind all sails out very cold.
at noon kept off for the Bark Stambole
gaming until seven had one whale
shorten sails all ends employed in
ship duty so ends this day.

Monday 20th Feb.

Strong breeze from the North West
blowed on until daylight keeping company
with the Bark Stambole hauled aback for
her hove about three hours for at ten
eight very heavy gail wore ship at four
took in the foretopsail and foresail
heading east lost sight of her at seven
down heavy fog and rain all hands
employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Tuesday 21st Feb.

Good weather all sails out steering close
to the wind at ten wind died out saw
one fimbals all hands employed in
ship duty so ends this day.

Wednesday 22nd Feb.

Good weather made the land went into
port harbor with Bark Stambole got the
ship ashore struck three times but got
off in one hour all hands employed in
ship duty so ends this day.

Thursday 23rd Feb.

Weather good, last night had a heavy gail
got off four casks of water went fishing
but did not get any broke out bread beans
flour beef and pork wash deer all
hands employed in ship duty so
ends this day.
