

Friday 24th Feb. /71.

Bad weather ship anchor in Port Harbor went on shore got some clams Schooner Emma Jane came in about one am. got some mackerel starting mast heads on the land all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Saturday 25th Feb.

Heavy rain light wind gaming with the schooner have the Stambole down to ^{stop the} leak which is bad at two good weather all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Sunday 26th Feb.

Fine weather still at anchor in Port Harbor I went on shore liberty one man B. heard run away went gaming got a lot of fowls all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Monday 27th Feb.

Good weather but very cold today had some cabbages all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Tuesday 28th Feb.

Heavy gail from the Westard went on shore to get some clams I got one panmilling string came on board at noon very cold all day all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Wednesday 1st March /71.

Heavy snow storm and a heavy gail went on board of the Schooner this morning came back at noon turn in for sleep all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Thursday 2nd March /71.

Very good weather at daylight called all hands to get ship under way had fowl cable but get it clear by eight the Bark Stambole and Schooner all left today washed off the deck ran down the land at noon reefed the topsails lifted to at one shorten shail for the night heading North East all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Friday 3rd March

Strong breeze from the North West closed reefed topsail at daylight wore ship, again wore ship at six light rain plenty of Timbrels all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Saturday 4th March

Strong breeze from the North West at daylight ship under closed reefed main topsail at ten keep ship off North East made sail all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Sunday 5th March.

Strong breeze from the North very warm all sails out heavy fog at times all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Monday 6th March.

Quite warm very heavy squalls all day steering North East at two took in the foretopsail close reefed the main heavy rain all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Tuesday 7th March.

Ship under short sails heavy fog to 11 ship at five heading North East all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.
