

Wednesday 8th March 1871.

Very warm at sundown raised a shoal of black fish ship under short sails light wind all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Thursday 9th March.

S^t PAULS

Long 77.35 E.

Fine weather at ten daylight raised the land St Pauls at ten sent two boats fishing had plenty fish came on board at sundown saw some men and women supposed to be sealing they came down on the rocks to mad sail keep off North and North West all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Friday 10th March.

Fine weather all sails out raised a Brick steering South East got the main-royal yard out to paint over holling the rigging steering North and North West, so ends this day.

Saturday March 11th 71.

Weather fine until noon strong breeze after dinner steering North North West all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Sunday March 12th.

Light gail all day shorten sail all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Monday 13th March 1871.

Very warm light wind washed ship all day and made some swabs all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Tuesday 14th March.

Warm light wind all ^{day} broke out this morning for lumber sheathing the decks all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Wednesday 15th March.

Quite warm light wind finished the decks, calm at four o'clock, our large boat sails ready, so ends this day.

Thursday 16th March

Squally weather, very warm, sent up the main-royal yard, calm, all hands employed in ship duty, so ends this day.

Friday 17th March.

Heavy rain and quite warm to, at times light wind all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Saturday 18th March.

Light wind, warm, doing nothing all day, so ends this day.

Sunday 19th March.

Very warm today, light wind all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Monday 20th March.

Light wind all day steering North West all hands employed in ship duty so ends this day.

Tuesday 21st March.

Warm, not much wind today broke out the main hold cooping bread and flour and stowed back so ends this day.
