

Tuesday 18th of July 1771.

Sent on shore two bags of bread and some meat, sugar, coffee, did not see anything so ends this day.

Wednesday 19th of July.

Heavy gail, ship under short sail steering North, one sail in sight, so ends this day.

Thursday 20th July.

Thick heavy weather, ship under short sail steering North, least very bad, so ends today.

Friday 21st July.

Light wind, one finback in sight, bread and water to eat, cook in iron, so ends this day.

Saturday 22nd July.

Strong breeze sent up the main-de-gallant yard and bent new sail light wind at sundown so ends this day.

Sunday 23rd July.

Heavy gail ship under close reefed main-top sail stove, Bombard heavy sea on so ends this day.

Monday 24th July.

Light wind but heavy sea, rain at noon, weather good at sundown, so ends this day.

Tuesday 25th July.

Plenty of Finbacks in sight, good weather, ship does not least much, so ends this day.

Wednesday 26th July.

This day light wind, humbacks and Porpoises in sight, so ends Wednesday.

Thursday 27th July.

One finback in sight light wind all day, so ends this day.

Friday 28th July 1771.

Making a new fore-top sail, light wind so ends this day.

Saturday 29th July.

Light wind all day, cook out today, all well so ends this day.

Sunday 30th July.

Don't do nothing today, light wind so ends Sunday.

Monday 31st July.

All sail out, light wind, steering West by North raised the Island of Rodrigue at sundown, so ends this day.

Tuesday 1st of August 1771.

Strong breeze, heavy squalls at times, one sail in sight, making a fore-top sail so ends this day.

Wednesday 2nd August.

Light wind at daylight raised Inanities, and at three o'clock this afternoon Bourbon was in sight, so ends this day.

Thursday 3rd of August.

Light wind, at one o'clock this morning, light of Bourbon hauled back head yards until daylight, run in, so the old man went on shore after letters, had some laying of and on all day, he came on board at four o'clock, so ends today.

Friday 4th of August.

Steering N. W. light wind and thick weather making a new foresail so ends this day.

Saturday 5th of August.

Washed ship all day light wind saw one humback so ends this day.
