

Sunday 3rd Sept 1877.

Strong breeze, ship under short sails, little rain at times, so ends this day.

Monday 4th Sept.

Steering by the wind, strong breeze, break out broad shorten sails for the night, so ends this day.

Tuesday 5th September.

Light wind, steering by the wind

Wednesday 6th Sept.

Light wind all day, had little rain this afternoon, shorten sails at sundown so ends this day.

Thursday 7th Sept.

Made sails this morning with a light wind, at ten came on its blow hard, shorten sails at noon, raised white water, could not know what it was, had a heavy squall at that time, bad weather at sundown, so ends this day.

Friday 8th Sept.

Strong wind today, ship under short sails, break out water this morning, raised the Island of Reunion, wore ship at sundown took in the foretop sail so ends this day.

Saturday 9th Sept.

Strong breeze ship under short sails, rain, all well so ends this day.

Sunday 10th Sept.

Light wind ship under short sails so ends this day.

Monday 11th Sept.

Light wind, raised a whale, could not know what he was, raised a sail four points on the weather bow, so ends this day.

Tuesday 12th September 1877.

Light wind all day, bent new foretop sail, one finback in sight so ends this day.

Wednesday 13th Sept.

Ship under short sails, light wind, steering North, raised the Isle of Reunion, Captain Caber fighting with the boy so ends this day.

Thursday 14th Sept.

Light wind all day run in for the land, saw a shoal of grampusses, and raised one sail near St. Paul, shorten sail for the night so ends this day.

Friday 15th Sept.

Light wind, land in sight and two sails, some finbacks in sight also, carried sails all night so ends this day.

Saturday 16th Sept.

Strong breeze from South East, one sail in sight, carried sails all night, steering North East, light wind all night so ends this day.

Sunday 17th Sept.

Mauritius in sight, steering North, one sail in sight, shorten sails, at sundown so ends this day.

Monday 18th Sept.

Strong breeze, tackled ship at sundown, five sails in sight so ends this day.

Tuesday 19th Sept.

Light breeze, Mauritius in sight and three sails, little rain, this afternoon break out tobacco, water and bread, flour, beef, and pork shorten sails at sundown.

Wednesday 20th Sept.

Light wind all day, one sail in sight and land, running off all day, shorten sails at sundown.
