

Thursday 21st September 1844.

Strong breeze, ship under short sails, land in sight all day. Kate sick, so ends this day.

Friday 22nd Sept.

Light wind, ship under short sails all day. Land in sight, raised one sail, so ends this day.

Saturday 23rd Sept.

Nice breeze, raised the Island of Reunion, two sails in sight, run off all day, shorten sails at sundown, so ends this day.

Sunday 24th Sept.

Light wind all day, running along the land. Three sails in sight, so ends this day.

Monday 25th Sept.

Light wind, sent up the fore-de-gallant mast and crossed the yard, all day doing it rattled down-mizzen-rigging-rigging, had mast-heads there so ends today.

Tuesday 26th Sept.

Light wind all day run for the Island of Reunion picking the chain plates for a worse up job and the pots and head chains close to the land at sun down so ends this day.

Wednesday 27th Sept.

Light wind all day. Land in sight painting the iron, so ends this day.

Thursday 28th Sept.

Light wind all day raised sperm whales at sunset this morning going to the wind and lost sight of them at ten o'clock. sails all night so ends this day.

Friday 29th September 1844.

Light wind saw one spout and one sail making, span yarn so ends this day.

Saturday 30th Sept.

Light wind raised the land and one sail making span yarn shorten sail at sundown so ends this day.

Sunday 1st October 1844.

Land in sight, gained the Martin today, she bound for home, 1000 lbs. one more sail in sight so ends this day.

Monday 2nd October.

Calm, and land in sight, all well, so ends this day.

Tuesday 3rd Octob.

Land in sight and two sails, all well, fine weather.

Wednesday 4th Octob.

Three or four sails in sight and land also, close to, all well so ends this day.

Thursday 5th Octob.

Land in sight, fine weather, so ends this day.

Friday 6th Octob.

Saw three sails today, close to the land, running down, all well so ends this day.

Saturday 7th Octob.

Lying off and on all day, at Saint Denis, had some potatoes, onions and other things, so ends this day.

Sunday 8th Octob.

Light wind all day so ends this day.

Monday 9th Octob.

Light wind broke out today, and fixed the cutting pennants, so ends this day.
