

Sunday 14th January 1872.

Light wind and rainy short sail all day
stowing down all done at night all well so
ends this day.

Monday 15th Janry.

Light wind all day and squall all sail out
running N. W. saw one Humpback at sun
set

Tuesday 16th January.

Strong wind running off until noon furl the fore-
top sail and close reefed maintop sail, left to the
wind saw a white water at four o'clock in the
afternoon all well so ends this day.

Wednesday 17th Janry.

We had a gale wind, it commences this morning
at four o'clock, furl the main-top sail and
sent down fore and main-de-gallant yards set
main-top sail at five so ends this day.

Thursday 18th Janry

Strong wind this morning and rain made all
sail at noon, one sail insight and fimbaco the
Old man broke out slop caen today for the men
shorten sail at sun set one man sick so ends
this day.

Friday 19th Janry

Strong wind all day, shorten sail on the
wind, had some rain all well so ends this day.

Saturday 20th Janry.

Strong wind all day under short sail on the
wind carrying sail tonight so ends this day.

Sunday 21st Janry

Strong wind on the wind shorten sail at sun
set one man sick so ends this day.

Monday 22nd Janry.

Strong wind under short sail had the potatoes
out to dry broke out flour one fimbaco in
sight so ends this day.

Tuesday 23rd January 1872.

Strong wind all day shorten sail running off mending
Main-top sail set it this afternoon left to the wind
and shorten sail for the night so ends this day.

Wednesday 24th Janry.

Strong wind all day running off land insight saw
two white water one sail insight broke out meat
and bread, coffee, rice, shorten sail for the night
and left to the wind all well so ends this day.

Thursday 25th Janry.

Strong wind all sail out sent the main-de-gallant
yard this morning and mended the main-de-
gallant sail, gained the Atlantic furl the fore-
top sail saw humpbacks this morning all well.

Friday 26th January.

Strong wind all day, under short sail broke out
water one sail insight shorten sail for the night
all well so ends this day.

Saturday 27th Janry.

Light wind all sail out running off saw a
school of Blackfish, broke out molasses, mend the
main-de-gallant sail and sent it up, shorten sail
for the night and left to the wind one sail insight
all well so ends this day.

Sunday 28th January.

Light wind all sail out on the wind saw a white
water at noon run down to the Barque *Laetitia* Atlantic
of New Bedford going home lowered a boat and
went on board of her so ends this day.

Monday 29th Janry.

Strong wind under short sail all day on the wind saw
one fimbaco and the Barque Atlantic in sight
all well so ends this day.

Tuesday 30th Janry.

Strong wind under short sail one sail insight
shorten sail tonight so ends this day.
