

Saturday 23rd March 1872.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out saw two white water one finback and porpoises broke out water and caught some fish repairing sails shorten sail for the night all well so ends this day.

Sunday 24th March.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out on the wind one finback and land in sight caught some fish one man sick shorten sail at sun down, all well.

Monday 25th March.

Fine weather all sail out on the wind finbacks hump-
-backs and land in sight two men sick. all well.

Tuesday 26th March.

Fine weather all sail out today row new main braces and break out bread saw one finback caught some fish carrying sail all day and night one man sick so ends this day.

Wednesday 27th March.

Light wind, squalls and some rain all sail out this morning one sail insight carrying all sail all well.

Thursday 28th March.

Light wind and rain all sail out on the wind had about eight bls. of water.

Friday 29th March.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out running off all day and night fixed a & double 1 to the pumps broke out bread and flour of the lower hold the Mate is sick so ends this day.

Saturday 30th March.

Fine weather light wind all sail out running off all day and night saw some finbacks caught some sharks so ends this day.

Sunday 31st of March 1872.

Light wind and rain all sail out saw one bell fish running off all day and night all well so ends this day.

Monday 1st of April

Strong wind and heavy rain squalls under short sail all day on the wind broke out flour we caught some fish had about six barrels of water carrying sail tonight all well so ends this day.

Tuesday 2nd April.

Light wind and rain all day had some water running short sail carrying sail tonight so ends this day.

Wednesday 3rd April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out running off all day and night one sail insight all well so ends this day.

Thursday 4th April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out raised sperm whales this morning about six lowered the four boats down had two Starboard Boat and Portboard boat W. and B. boats chase them all day and did not get any came on board at sun set get the whale along side before dark one sail insight shorten sail for the night all well so ends this day.

Friday 5th April

Fine weather and light wind all day we commence to cut this morning about six o'clock we got them cut in about ten this morning and commence to boil, the decks was clear about four and broke out meat we made sail this morning at ten all day and night carrying sail all night boiling so ends this day.

Saturday 6th April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out running off all day we cool down about noon saw one white water shorten sail at sun set so ends this day.
