

Sunday 7th April 1872.

Fine weather and strong wind running off all day under short sail on the wind at sun set. all well.

Monday 8th April.

Fine weather and strong wind carrying sail all day and night stow down the oil today and ~~wait~~ the holes saw one finback all well so ends this day.

Tuesday 9th April.

Strong wind all day on the wind shorten sail one man sick shorten sail at sun set ~~ends~~ today.

Wednesday 10th April.

Strong wind carrying sail all day and night on the wind wait the holes this afternoon the cooper is sick so ends this day.

Thursday 11th April.

Strong wind and rain squalls all day carrying sail shorten sail at sun down ~~the~~ still sick.

Friday 12th April.

Strong wind and rain squalls carrying sail all day and night wore ship at dark the cooper still sick so ends this day.

Saturday 13th April.

Strong wind all day shorten sail running off saw one finback running off all night wait the holes today all well so ends this day.

Sunday 14th April

Strong wind all day short sail on the wind all day and night all well so ends this day.

Monday 15th April.

Strong wind and heavy squalls this morning made all sail at noon carrying all night broke out bread and water, & cooper marking buckets today one sail in sight all well so ends this day.

Tuesday 16th April 1872

Light wind today all sail out on the wind wait the holes this morning all sail out at sun set cooper marking buckets all well so ends this day. Two men had a work job for fighting

Wednesday 17th April

Fine weather and light wind all sail out on the wind all day and night saw one finback all well.

Thursday 18th April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out on the wind cooper off duty so ends this day.

Friday 19th April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out on the wind broke meat and water & men sick so ends this day.

Saturday 20th April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out raised the Island of Bourbon about ten this morning on the wind three men sick so ends this day.

Sunday 21st April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out working up for the Land the Land is to the windward of us all sail out at dark at sun down one sail in sight three men sick so ends this day.

Monday 22nd April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out one sail and Land in sight broke out and stowed back ready for water all sail out at sun set, calm, two men off duty so ends this day.

Tuesday 23rd April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out saw gram-
- pusses and one finback one sail, Bourbon and
Isauritius in sight we had one pump out and
repaired it and put it back shorten sail for the
night one man sick.
