Fine weather and light wind all sail out on the wind all day grampusses and Land in sight one man sick shorten sail for the night so ends this day.

Thursday 25th April

Fine weather and light wind all sail out on the wind all day wash ship one man sick shorten sail for the night so ends this day.

Friday 26th April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out on the wind broke out bread and water grampusses and Land in sight, ^{cooper} making buckets, he commence duty today short sail tonight so ends this day one man sick — "Saturday 27th April." —

Fine weather and light wind all sail out running for Land wait holes this morning and broke out molasses three sails in sight, bittling up to St. Denis one man sick so ends this day.

Sunday 28th April.

Fine weather and light wind all sail out had up the chains this morning. raised sperm whales about three o'clock this afternoon lowered all the four boats down but did not get any laying of and on tonight at St Denis two sails in sight an other ship anchored along the Land one man sick so ends this day.

Monday 29th April.

Fine weather and light wind running for the port of St Denis we came to anchor about noon furl the sails and wash the ship ready for painting the captain the captain went on shore and got the letters send them on board I got two letters from home one man sick so ends this day.

Tuesday 30th April.

Fine weather the old man came off this morning and the Starboard watch went on shore and Carboard watch painting the ship at sun down the boat went in for the watch

one man sick so ends this day.

Wednesday 1st April.

Sent the Carboard watch on shore the Starboard watch painting ship one man sick so ends this day.

Thursday 2nd April.

Two men ~~run~~ run away, fine weather, the watch on shore Starboard^d painting ship one man sick so ends this day.

Friday 3rd April.

Fine weather sent the watch on liberty painting ship one man sick so ends this day.

Saturday 4th April.

Fine weather sent the watch on liberty painting ship one man sick so ends this day.

Sunday 5th April.

Fine weather sent the watch on shore one man sick so ends this day.

Monday 6th May.

The water boat came off sent Manuel Nagoera to the Hospital so ends this day.

Tuesday 7th May.

Fine weather sent two boats in for recruits all well.

Wednesday 8th May

Fine weather in port painting boat had eight casks of molasses, one man sick so ends this day.

Thursday 9th May.

Rain all day took one boat off the house and put on the Waist cranes we had a heavy rain squall last night one barque came in last night and a Brig today one man sick so ends this day.

Friday 10th May.

Fine weather today in port got off some potatoes and onions, the ship ready for sea one man off duty.
