

Barque Pacific Cruising In The South

Tuesday Jan. 26th All day gales of wind from the S.W. and W. and overcast with fog, and some rainy - Ship by the wind to the S.W. and E. with small sail - Nothing in sight - Water blue and clear nearly all day with some fish and birds. Lat 41 27 Long 84.00

Wednesday Jan. 27th First part light breezes from the S and W. and quite fine weather with a short choppy sea on - all night being very squally with heavy thunder and vivid lightning - Ship to the S and E. with all sail out - Water very green - Nothing in sight indicating whales

Thursday Jan 28th All day strong gales from S. S. E. and squally weather with a rough choppy sea on - Ship steering N.W. E. by N. with all prudent sail out - Nothing in sight all day but birds and several schools of albacore - Water of a milky green until 12 M. then changed to blue - and remained the same all the P.M. Lat 39 46 Long 83.46

Friday Jan 29th All day fresh breezes from W. S.W. and fine weather - Ship by the wind heading N. nearly all day - all A.M. in green water at 12 M. got into blue and remained the same all the P.M. at 4 spoke and jammed with Bk. leam. Morris - had seen nothing since we last saw her Lat 38.46 Long 81.50

Saturday Jan. 30th First part moderate breezes from S.W. and fine weather - Ship by the wind to the S. E. in company with leam. Morris in the morn. saw a stranger whale - standing to the S. W. with topsails out - Nothing more in sight all day - water blue and green alternately - no indications of whales Lat. 36 46 Long 80.55

Atlantic Ocean In The Year of 1875

Sunday Jan. 31st All day light winds from the south and fine weather - Ship steering S.W. all the A.M. in the P.M. to the N. in lee with Bk. leam. Morris - spoke and jammed with her at 2 P.M. both ships steering to the S. Lat 36.02 Long 49.50 N.

Monday February 1st Comes in with light breezes from the W. and clear weather - Ship steering to the S. with all sail out in lee with Bk. leam. Morris nearly all the A.M. in green water - no indications of whales - in the P.M. in blue water - saw two sail steering to the S.W. Lat 36.33 Long 50.00 W

Tuesday February 2d All day moderate breezes from the W. and fine pleasant weather - Ship steering to the S. E. by N. with all prudent sail out cruising in lee with Bk. leam. Morris - Nothing in sight indicating whales - water blue all day but a few birds - No porpoises or other indications of whales Lat 34 30 Long 49.0

Wednesday Feb. 3d All day light baffling airs from the W. and S. E. and calm - Ship by the wind in the P.M. to the S. E. with all sail out - cruising in lee with leam. Morris - saw two or three sail merchantmen steering to the S. E. - Nothing more in sight - saw several schools of Grampuses - Water blue all day with only a few tallow Drops in it Lat. 32 40 Long 47.25

Thursday Feb. 4th All day moderate breezes from the S.W. ship by the wind with all sail out - cruising for sperm - saw two sail steering to the S. E. - water in the morn rather green but afterwards blue - saw several schools of Grampuses in school of porpoises - nothing more indicating whales
