

Barque Pacific Cruising In The North

Wednesday July 28th all day strong gales from the South and squally weather with much rain - at 3 P.M. wind changed to the N. and cleared up a little - saw one sail steering to the E. also saw a steamer steering to the W. Ship all day under short sail being very poor seeing. No Obs.

Thursday July 29th all day strong breezes from N.E. & E. and quite good seeing - water Green all day nor can we find any blue - in the A.M. steering various courses, in the P.M. steering S.W. per compass with the view of getting to the S of the Green water if possible it being very Green all day - saw several sail through the day some to the E and others to the W.
Lat. 49.01 Long. 25.00 W

Friday July 30th all day moderate breezes from the E & S.E. with fog & calms - ship steering S.W. with all prudent sail out having steered that course all night with the view of getting through the Green water not being able to find any blue on or near our whaling ground at 10 A.M. got into blue water - spoke a Norwegian Barque 33 days from the River St. Lawrence with lumber for West coast of Ireland whose estimated Long. is 30.
Lat. 47.04 Long. 27.00 W

Saturday July 31st all day light air and calms - from the E. with fine weather & good seeing - ship steering W.N.W. with all sail out - nothing in sight but porpoises and Grampuses - Water blue with plenty of Yellow Drops and jellies
Lat. 46.44 Long. 28.15 W

Sunday Aug. 1st all day light air from the S.E. and fine weather and good seeing - ship steering W.N.W. with all sail out - good seeing - water all the A.M. blue, in the P.M. passed through a spot of Green water - saw three or four schools of porpoises and several schools of Grampuses and in the P.M. saw many birds and plenty of Yellow Drops
Lat. 46.33 Long. 28.30

Atlantic Ocean In The Year of 1875

Monday Aug. 2d all day moderate breezes from the S. and fine pleasant weather good seeing - ship cruising on different tracks cruising for whales - saw several schools of Grampuses & porpoises - water blue and Green alternately - several sail in sight all steering to the E. but one going to the W. - Nothing indicating Whales
Lat. 46.40 Long. 28.50 W

Tuesday Aug. 3d all day strong gales from the S. and overcast looking much like rain - ship by the wind to the W. with all prudent sail out cruising - in the P.M. rainy - at 6 P.M. wind changed to the N.W. with heavy squalls - one sail in sight in the A.M. steering to the N.E. - water blue all day with some birds and porpoises & Grampuses
Lat. 46.24 Long. 29.59

Wednesday Aug. 4th all day moderate breezes from N.W. & W. and fine pleasant weather - ship steering S.E. in the A.M. and S.W. in the P.M. - water blue & clear - Nothing in sight all day but one sail steering to the N.E. - saw a few birds at night took in sail
Lat. 46.04 Long. 30.12 W

Thursday Aug. 5th all day fresh breezes from the N.W. and overcast - ship all night under easy sail at 7 A.M. kept off S.W. with all prudent sail out - water ^{blue} until 10 A.M. then entered blue - saw some birds and two schools of porpoises - one sail in sight steering to the E.
Lat. 45.38 Long. 31.41 W

Friday Aug. 6th comes in with light air from the N.W. and hazy weather - ship steering to the S.W. with all sail out - nothing in sight indicating whales all day but Green water with a few Yellow Drops &c
No Obs. This day.
