

Barque Pacific Cruising in the

Thursday Oct. 19th All day strong gales from N.W. and squally weather - Ship steering W.S.W. per compass with all prudent sail out. In the P.M. saw two sails steering to the E.N.E. - nothing indicating whales - water in the A.M. Green, in the P.M. blue
Lat. 40.21 Long 50.50

Friday Oct. 20th Comes in with moderate breezes from N. and somewhat squally - Ship steering W.S.W. with all sail out, but H.S.G.S. cruising - in the A.M. sent down foresail for repairs - Three sail in sight steering to the E.N.E. - water blue with some Gulf Weed, Temp 72 all P.M. calm Lat. 38.21 Long. 51.54

Saturday Oct. 21st Comes in with squally weather, winds from W.S.W. to N.W. - Ship by the wind on different tacks cruising with all prudent sail out - Nothing in sight but Gulf Weed and one school of porpoises Lat 38.13

Sunday Oct. 22^d Comes in with moderate breezes from E.S.E. and quite fine weather - Ship steering W. per compass with all sail out cruising - Saw White Water in the A.M. supposed to be Grampuses - in the A.M. Water Blue in the P.M. Green - Nothing but two or three birds and Gulf Weed in sight all day Lat. 37.41 Long 53.36 W.

Monday Oct. 23^d Comes in with fresh breezes from E.S.E. and cloudy weather - Ship steering W. N.W. per compass with all sail out cruising - Nothing in sight but Gulf Weed all day - Watch cleaning, Craft. &c
Lat 37.33 Long 56.01 W.

North Atlantic Ocean in the year of 1876

Tuesday Oct. 24th Comes in with a gale from S.E. and squally weather - thick and rainy - poor seeing - Ship steering W. by N per compass with all prudent sail out cruising - Nothing in sight but one finback and Gulf Weed - at 5 P.M. calm and at 6 wind came out suddenly to the N.W. and blowing heavy, nearly all night going to with all sail in but main spinnaker
Lat. 37.41 Long 59.17

Wednesday Oct. 25th All day strong gales from the W. and overcast with squalls of rain - Ship by the wind cruising with all prudent sail out - Nothing in sight but one finback and some Gulf weed - very rough
Lat. 37.38 Long 60.45

Thursday Oct. 26th All day strong gales from N.W. and rainy weather - Ship by the wind to the W.S.W. with all prudent sail out - nothing in sight but one flock of birds - Gulls - and some Gulf Weed - water blue and clear
Lat. 38.33 No Long.

Friday Oct. 27th All day light baffling winds from all points of the compass, and squalls of rain - Ship cruising to the W. with all prudent sail out - water blue with Gulf Weed - One sail steering to Bark Bazard of Boston - passed at 7 A.M. and a Steamer bound W. passed at 12 M. - all that has been seen today, with the exception of two or three birds -
Lat 37.39
