

Wednesday Feb 22^d 1843

These 24 hours moderate breezes from NW pleasant weather steering ENE with all sail set men employed tarring down rigging

Thursday Feb 23^d

These 24 hours pleasant gales first part NW latter westward light airs fine weather at 8 AM unlent the main and commenced repairing it so ends these 24 hours

Lat 30-30 N
Long 163-46 W

Friday Feb 24th

These 24 hours variables winds and calms pleasant weather steering NE with all sail set finished repairing the main sail and bent it so ends

Lat 29-34 N
Long 164-25 W

Saturday Feb 25th

First part light breezes from westward pleasant weather steering NE with all sail set latter part east weather strong breezes from SE so ends

Lat 28-03 N
Long 162-53 W

Sunday Feb 26th 1843

All of these 24 hours fresh gales from ESE and over cast weather steering NW first part all sail set latter took in the fore and mizzen top gallant sails and hauled down the studding sails so ends

Lat 26-11 N
Long 161-17 W

Monday Feb 27th

First part strong breezes from east over cast weather steering NE middle and latter variables winds and rainy

Lat 22-14 N
Long 161-12 W

Tuesday Feb 28th

First part light breezes from South ward steering NE latter variable winds and pleasant weather at 6 AM made the land Oratory bearing NE by compass distant 40 miles

Lat 21-27 N
Long 161-11 W

Wednesday Feb March 1st

First part light breezes from south ward steering for the land latter rainy lying off and on Oratory getting off vessel in company with the sloop of Nantucket sent vessel 14 months ago so ends no obs
