Sunday, Mar 19th 1843

All of these 24 hours strong breezes from
north and east north steering north and
westward with all drawing sail set to the haly.

Sat 3 = 32
Long 158 = 43 W

Monday, March 20th

All of these 24 hours strong breezes from
eastward and pleasant weather steering
northward close hauled to the wind
with all sail set so ends

Sat 3 = 16 B
Long 159 = 02 W

Tuesday, March 21st

These 24 hours pleasant gales from eastward
and pleasant weather steering N E
with all sail set at 11 1/2 o'clock sun
Sperm whales so ends

Sat 2 = 5 B
Long 159 = 05 W

Wednesday, Mar 22^d

These 24 hours pleasant gales from east
ward and fine weather at 2 P M lower
for sperm whales in company with the
Barque clarry of near heard 15 months
out 140 lbs at 8 o'clock lower for whales
but without success so ends struck one and
drummed from him

Sat 1 = 50 B
Long 159 = 00 W

Voyage Hon-lord Gearing Masters

Thursday, Mar 23^d 1843

These 24 hours light variable winds
and calms with pleasant weather seen
sperm whales lower for them but all
in vain later steering northward
with all drawing sail set employed
fitting of new boat so ends

Sat 1 = 13 B
Long 159 = 20 W

Friday, Mar 24th

These 24 hours variable winds with
pleasant weather steering north and
eastward with all sail set so ends

Sat 200 = 16 B
Long 159 = 39 W

Saturday, Mar 25th

All of these 24 hours strong breezes from
N E S pleasant weather steering
N E S with all drawing sail set
fitted at new boat and painted her
so ends

Sat 1 = 24 W
Long 159 = 22 W
Long 158 = 32

Sunday, Mar 26th

These 24 hours strong breezes from
eastward pleasant weather steering N W
with all sail set so ends

Sat 4 = 00 W
Long 158 = 50 W
