

Monday April 19th 1845

First part fresh gale from south west with rainy foggy weather steering off by W at 3 P M double reefed the top sails at 6 hauled fore and mizen top sails at 8 & m hauled the foresail and luff the ship to the wind heading off W under close reefed main top sail & gale from W S W over cast weather so ends

Lat 41 = 28 N

Long 164 = 10 W

Tuesday April 20th

All of the 24 hours a heavy gale of wind from west north with squalls of hail rain and snow first heading off W at 8 & all more ship so ends lying to under close reefed main top sail and fore top mast stay sail.

Lat 43 = 01 N

Long 163 = 47 W

Friday April 22^d

First part a gale from west north with squalls of hail and rain lying to under close reefed main top sail heading S S W latter more moderate make sail steering North over cast weather at 10 & all unhook the main top sail and bent another so ends

Lat 43 = 54 N

Long 163 = 35 W

Saturday April 23^d 1845

First part moderate breezes from south over cast weather steering off with all sail set middle and latter a gale from East steering North under close reefed top sails with thick rainy foggy weather so ends

Lat 45 = 20 N

Long 162 = 35 W

Sunday April 24th 1845

First part strong winds from S S W with thick rainy foggy weather steering North and in close reef top sail at 6 take in the fore and mizen top sails and luff the ship to the wind heading W S W at 6 & all more moderate set fore and mizen top sail steering north at 11 took in the fore and mizen top sails & 1 P M broke out for water & end at 6 P M set the watch boat crews

Lat 46 = 48 N

Long 160 = 10 W

Monday April 25th

All the 24 hours a gale from south and east with first part rainy foggy weather steering North under close reefed main top sail fore sail at 6 P M take in the fore sail and luff to the wind heading E S E at 6 set the watch boat crews

Lat 47 = 54 N

Long 159 = 51 W

Tuesday Apr 26th

First part fresh gale from S S E with squalls of rain steering E S E under close reefed main top sail and foresail latter more moderate all sail set at 6 & all broke out for provisions

Lat 48 = 09 N

Long 158 = 20 W

Wednesday April 27th

First part strong breezes from south over cast weather steering north at 6 P M shorten sail at 5 & all all hands make sail again wind S W with squalls of rain and hail saw five larks

Lat 49 = 45 N

Long 157 = 10 W
