Saturday August 13th 1843

First part strong breezes from south over
cast weather latter more moderate light winds
from S.E. fine weather craping bone
saw five whales so ends

Sat 24 = 14 1/2

Long 150 = 29 1/2

Sunday August 14th

First part light breezes from S.E. and pleasant
weather latter light airs and calms steering S.E.
all sail set so ends

Sat 26 = 36 1/2

Long 150 = 56 1/2

Monday August 15th

These 24 hours light airs and calms pleasant
weather steering S.B.E. with all sail set
so ends

Sat 28 = 29 1/2

Long 151 = 06 1/2

151 = 06

1843 Tuesday August 16th 1843

This day one year from frame with 1400
lbs of oil on board 250 sp and 1400 of whale
behind in to make. First part light airs
and calms at 3 P.M. saw a whale going quick
at 7 M. lower for him but all in vain steering
S.B.E. latter strong gales from north steering
S.E. with all sail set so ends fine weather

Sat 43 = 39 1/2

Long 151 = 46 1/2

Wednesday August 17th 1843

All of these 24 hours a heavy gale from north
ward over cast weather first part wind north steering
S.E. latter wind hauls to the N.E. steering
S.E. all sail set so ends

Sat 40 = 13 1/2

Long 151 = 10 1/2

Thursday August 18th

All of these 24 hours heavy gales from north over
cast weather first part steering S.E. latter
steering South all sail set so ends

Sat 37 = 09 1/2

Long 150 = 50 1/2

Friday August 19th

First part strong gales from north over cast
weather steering South all sail set latter light
breezes from westward pleasant weather break-
ing out between decks and stowing bone and
water so ends fine weather

Sat 35 = 02 1/2

Long 151 = 20 1/2

Saturday August 20th

These 24 hours small breezes from west
ward pleasant weather men employed budder-
ing bone and stowing it below so ends steering
S.B.W. all sail set

Sat 32 = 11 1/2

Long 152 = 11 1/2
