

Monday August 22nd 1843

These 24 hours light airs and calms with fine weather at 6 A.M. came to anchor so ends one watch on shore on the island of Ulloa.

Tuesday August 30th

These 24 hours light airs and calms pleasant weather lying at anchor one watch on shore liberty so ends this day the ship arrived and Logan came to anchor this day was discharged from the ship Pacific on the account of ill health.

Wednesday August 31st

These 24 hours light airs and calms pleasant weather lying at anchor one watch on shore so ends.

Ship "Huntress" of New Bedford
voyage began Aug. 20 1841

Friday Sep 1st

These 24 hours strong trades with pleasant at 9 A.M. went on board of the ship Huntress of New Bedford bound to New Bedford at 10 A.M. took the anchor bound to Whakoo so ends.

Saturday Sep 2^d

These 24 hours strong trades and pleasant weather at 9 A.M. came to anchor in the outer harbour so ends at 3 P.M. a man died with the consumption a native of Rarotonga the carpenter makes a coffin so ends.

Sunday Sep 3^d 1843

These 24 hours strong breezes and pleasant weather lying at anchor in the outer harbour at 3 P.M. carried the corps on shore and back to German preached in the lecture so ends.

Monday Sep 4th

These 24 hours strong breezes and fine weather at 5 A.M. the Pilot came on board and took her into the inner harbour at 9 came to anchor at the inner harbour and commenced breaking out oil and found it in good order latter stowing down again so ends.

Tuesday Sep 5th 1843

These 24 hours light airs and pleasant weather lying at anchor one watch on shore so ends taking water on board.

Wednesday Sept 6th

First part light winds and pleasant weather latter rainy lying at anchor one watch on shore so ends.

Thursday Sept 7th 1843

These 24 hours strong breezes and pleasant weather painted the starboard bend one watch on shore so ends.
