These 24 hours strong trades and pleasant weather
first part of stowed the anchors and unbent
the chains and stowed them below steering to
the south eastward close hauled to the wind
employed at ships duty so ends

Sat 20 = 00

Long 154 = 30

Saturday Sept 16th

These 24 hours trades with frequent squalls of
rain steering south and eastward

Sat 18 = 00

Long 156 = 78

Sunday Sept 17th

These 24 hours strong trades and pleasant
weather steering south easterly all sails
set so ends

Sat 16 = 42

Long 155 = 40
