These 24 hours light variable winds and calm with pleasant weather at 2 P.M. the boat came on board we got 2 boat loads of bread and a few potatoes and bananas and some apples & pears and some lemons at 2 P.M. sent the yards and kept her away S.E. for large horn at 8 P.M. took a lunar observation took the distance between the sun and moon latter watch employed in fitting the lub. try and setting up the lub. try so ends

These 24 hours light air and calms with beautiful weather steering S.E. to S.E. with all sail set employed setting up and fitting the fore rigging at 8 P.M. set up the blacksmith forge the mate to work at the forge repairing the coals canner so ends at 9 P.M. took a lunar observation

Wednesday Oct 18th

These 24 hours light winds and calms with pleasant weather steering southward employed in repairing the old main top sail the mate to work at the forge at 4 P.M. caught a shark 2 men off duty latter making gun jam so ends Lat By Observation

Thursday Oct 19th 1848

First part fine breezes from E.S.E. steering S.E. with all sail set pleasant weather mate to work at the forge watch employed in repairing main top sail and making spare spare latter over east weather wind E steering S.E. with the fore top mast steering sail set at 6 P.M. till 6 P.M. at 9 P.M. the top gilliant studding sails at 11 commences raining so ends

Friday Oct 20th

These 24 hours commences with strong breezes from E steering S.E. & rainy weather at 3 P.M. winds shifted to S with heavy squalls of wind and rain took the sail down to double reefed the sails latter more moderate all sail at 3 P.M. tacked ship heading E.S.E. pleasant weather employed in repairing the fore spruces

Saturday Oct 21st

These 24 hours pleasant gales at south end only with pleasant weather at half past 12 tacked ship heading S.E. all sail set employed in repairing an old top gilliant sail at 4 P.M. finished it at 5 P.M. rest hale son squid and olivers sons light winds and beautiful weather so ends
