

Thursday Dec 28th 1845

First part light breeze from S steering in for
Sonia Cruz harbor at 4 P.M. took a line E.S. water
at 4 P.M. set 90 sur anchor in S. 3/4 N. of water
S. 1/2 E. bearing S. 60 E. Dist 3/4 of a league
at 4 P.M. lighted our anchor into 4 ft of water and
all our last load of wood so end line weather
105 Days from the Sandwich Islands and 14 from Orotonia
about 28 from Cape Horn et nona long passage

Friday Dec 29th

These 24 hours strong breezes from S. E. with squalls
of rain employed getting off wood at 1 P.M. the boat arri
ved from St. Katherine latter part steady employed gett
ing off wood and painting the spars at 6 P.M. the
boat left for the town so ends lying at anchor at
St. Cruz

Saturday Dec 30th

These 24 hours strong breezes from S. E. and rain
lying at anchor at St. Cruz at 4 P.M. the boat
came from St. Katherine latter pleasant weather employe
painting spars so ends these 24 hours

Sunday Dec 31st 1845

These 24 hours pleasant weather and fine breezes
from S. E. first part employed painting latter one
match on shore lying at anchor at St. Cruz

Monday January 1st 1846

These 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather
one match on shore liberty lying at anchor at St.
Cruz so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Jan 2^d

First part light breezes and pleasant weather
one match on liberty at 7 P.M. all hands on board
latter fresh breeze from N. W. and fine weather at
5 P.M. took our anchor and made sail for the U.S.
at 10 P.M. went the cables and stowed them below
and stowed the anchors at the east end of the boat
arrived bearing S. E. 1/2 S. Dist 1 league so ends steering
S. E. wind S. Sat 27.25 S Long 48.10 W

Wednesday Jan 3^d

These 24 hours strong breezes at N. and S. E.
and pleasant weather steering ship by the wind
employed hoisting coffee so ends these 24 hours
Sat 28.5 S Long 46.1

Thursday Jan 4th

These 24 hours strong breezes from S. E. and pleasant
weather steering E. and S. E. at 5 P.M. set employed rep
airing an old fore top sail at 6 P.M. finished it so ends
Sat 28.50 S Long 46.10
