from London bound to Demerara so end C.C.

These 24 hours light airs and calms and pleasant
weather steering N. by E. with all sail set improved ship
duty so ends these 24 hours saw gull meat

weather better strong breezes from N. by E. steering
N. by E. with all sail set saw a ship steering N. by E.
at 11 o'clock another astern steering N. by E.

First part strong breezes from N. by E. and pleasant we-
