

Sunday February 18<sup>th</sup> 1844.

First part moderate breezes from S.E. and  
about 6 P.M. wind shifted sailing to S.E.  
with strong wind and rain. Hauled sail down  
to double reef top sail at 4 parted the back wire  
of the main top sail, dived it up and perked it  
and reefed the main sail and set it at 11 wind  
hauled to S.E. latter light air from S.E. and pleasant  
weather steering N.W. at 1 P.M. one ship in sight and  
set sail.

Monday Feb 19<sup>th</sup>.

These 24 hours first part light air and calm with no  
sailing weather steering N.W. at 1 P.M. with all sail set  
at 4 P.M. shifted the fore and main top sails with  
light wind from N.W. latter strong breezes at 8  
P.M. arrived at 11 at 10 tick in top gallant sail  
and single reefed the main top sail so ends

Tuesday Feb 20<sup>th</sup>

These 24 hours first part from N.W. to S.E. and over  
weather steering N.W. at 1 P.M. at 4 P.M. first part under  
top sail and double reefed the fore and main top sails  
under double reefed top sail and courses latter  
all sail set so ends heading N.W. by N.

Wednesday February 21<sup>st</sup> 1844.

First part strong breezes from S.E. and thick weather  
middle light winds and rain at 2 at 10 the wind  
hauled to S at 11 hauled to N at 1 P.M. strong breezes  
steering N.W. at 10 heading N.W. at 10 sail set

Thursday Feb 22<sup>nd</sup>

First part strong breezes at N.W. and cloudy  
heading N.W. middle part wind of N and N.W.  
at 8 at 10 ticked ship to N.W. latter light air  
and calm pleasant weather at 10 commenced heaving  
the log works over board so ends fine weather calm

Friday Feb 23<sup>rd</sup>

First part fine breezes at N.W. and pleasant  
weather employed heaving the log works over board  
at finished and washed the decks middle and latter  
fine breezes from N.W. to S.W. and thick weather

Saturday Feb 24<sup>th</sup>

First part moderate breezes from S.W. and thick weather  
steering N.W. middle squalls of rain at 4 at 10 wind

main top sails
