

Sunday August 24th 1822 begins with light
Winds from WSW Course South at 6 P.M. Steered
SSE fresh winds and squally though the
light at 6 P.M. Steered SSE fresh winds
and cloudy weather so ends this day
Lat 13° 10' N Long 16° 33' West

Monday August 26th 1822 begins with fresh winds
from WSW and cloudy steering SSE
at 6 P.M. Steered SSE fresh winds though
the light at day light the weather green
at 8 P.M. Sounded and got ground in 17 fathoms
after haul bottom with fine red sand
the wind at 1 P.M. hauled down on board in 158
So ends light wind and hazy weather
Lat 13° 9' 54" N Long 14° 38' West

Tuesday August 27th 1822 all this 24 hours
light winds from WSW and clear weather
the Schuman at all sail steering to the
South on board at 3 P.M. Sounded
in 20 fathoms at daylight 30 fathoms
at 2 P.M. 50 fathoms at 4 P.M. Bottom
the latter part light wind steering
SSE So ends this day
Lat 13° 3' 38" N Long 14° 38' West

Wednesday August 28th 1822 begins with light
from NNE and clear weather the Schuman
at all sail steering SSE at 1 P.M. the wind
and latter part fresh winds and cloudy
So ends steering SSE
Lat 13° 6' 47" N Long 13° 26' West

Thursday August 29th 1822 begins with fresh winds
from SSW and cloudy the latter part
the Schuman with the heavy swell from SSW
the latter part moderate Course SSE at all times
Lat 13° 6' 22" N Long 12° 00' West

Friday August 30th 1822 begins with light winds
from SSW and clear weather at 7 P.M. Made the
Land of Cape Meruado bearing E by N Distance
6 Leagues at 6 P.M. the Land from SE Course
SSE at 8 P.M. the wind shifted SSW Steered
SSE light winds though the light
at 6 P.M. Steered SSE under all sail so ends this
Lat 13° 2' 22" N Long 9° 03' West
Cape Meruado in in Lat 6° 29' North Long 10° 36' West
From which I take my Departure

Sat 31st 1822 all this 24 hours fresh winds from
WSW the first part steering SSE at 8 P.M.
Steered SSE at 6 P.M. Steered SSE in green
Water at 8 P.M. Sounded from 100 Bottom with
50 fathoms line the latter part cloudy so ends
Lat 13° 13' N Long 8° 35' West

Sunday Sept 1st 1822 all this 24 hours fresh
Winds from SSW and cloudy the Schuman
at all sail that would do steering SE the latter
part clear weather so ends this day
Lat 13° 3' 27" N Long 6° 40' West

Monday Sept 2nd 1822 all this 24 hours fresh breeze
from SSW the Schuman under all sail that
would do steering SSE at 8 P.M.
at 8 P.M. got to Luncan at 10 and made the long 5° 16' West
from with Sounded got to Bottom with 50 fathoms
Lat 13° 3' 20" N Long 4° 09' West by dead

Tuesday Sept 3rd 1822 all this 24 hours light
Winds from SSW the first part with part
steering SE the latter part steering
SSE the latter part the weather so ends this
SSE under all sail
Lat 13° 2' 53" N Long 2° 09' West
