

Wednesday October 9th 1822 begins with fresh winds
from S.W. and light rains get the cutting Sucker
blaft to begin to cut get some in the morning
on the 10th S.W. (S.W. S.W.) down to light
begin to cut to gain the 10th of night and
made sail so on the 11th the west part of
the Island bearing South 20 Miles Dist.

Thursday October 10th 1822 begins with fresh winds
and clear began to boil the S.W. and
short sail standing on to wind to the
S.W. the middle and salt part light winds
the first spoke of the Island bearing S.E.
40 Miles Dist so on Boiling.

Friday October 11th 1822 till three hours light
winds from S.W. and clear weather
on the 12th I stood to the Southward on
on to wind so on Boiling the
Island of St. John bearing East 20 Miles

Saturday October 12th 1822 begins with light winds
and clear with the S.W. wind till
standing on to wind to the South till 6 AM
finished Boiling at 8 Sunshades and
one the Sun for the 12th and the 13th
killed the Sun and west on so on this day

Sunday October 13th 1822 begins with light
winds from S.W. and clear weather
off the 14th and struck the 15th
Largish tub to 30 M took her along
side took the Sun and on the 16th
at 4 PM so on this day
bearing East 20 Miles

Monday October 14th 1822 begins with light
winds from S.W. and clear weather
the 15th and on the 16th finished 57
at 6 AM began to cut on the 17th
and cut the sun and fresh winds
begin to get the head up so on this

Tuesday October 15th 1822 begins with light
winds from S.W. and clear weather
cutting the 16th and on the 17th
Rope started made till the 18th
begin to get the 19th till 5 PM
at the 20th I took the 21st
on the 22nd the 23rd so on Boiling

Wednesday October 16th 1822 begins with light
winds from S.W. and clear weather
the 17th and on the 18th I took
part the Sun so on Boiling

Thursday October 17th 1822 till three hours
light winds from S.W. and clear weather
short sail standing on to wind to the
S.W. the 18th part finished Boiling
the 19th and on the 20th the Island
bearing S.E.

Friday October 18th 1822 till three hours
light winds from S.W. and clear weather
the 19th and on the 20th the Island
bearing S.E.

Saturday October 19th 1822 till three hours
light winds from S.W. and clear weather
the 20th and on the 21st the Island
bearing S.E. the 22nd part of the
37 bbls of oil so on this day 37 bbls and 11 gals

Sunday October 20th 1822 begins with light
winds from S.W. and clear weather
the 21st and on the 22nd the Island
bearing S.E. the 23rd part of the
standing in front the Island on to wind
see to the Sun for back so on the Island
bearing S.E. Dist 20 Miles

Monday October 21st 1822 till three hours light
winds from S.W. and clear weather
the 22nd and on the 23rd the Island
bearing S.E. the 24th part of the
