

Sat May 3 rd 1823	All this 24 hours Moderate winds from E & E and Clear weather the Sch under all Sail the first part Steering W by N to 6 to 11 then at Ship Steering to the Northward and Oblique standing to the N. and I jibed then I Steered west to E. in this way Lat 06° 13' 13 South Long 135° 37 West
Sunday May 4 th 1823	the first part light winds from E & E and Clear weather the Sch under all Sail that would do at Steering W by N to 6 to 11 then I fresh winds though the wind is to E & N Steered W by N the W by E and I fresh Breezes and Clear weather to End. this day Lat 06° 12' 13 South Long 135° 02 West
Monday May 5 th 1823	All this 24 hours fresh Winds from E & E and Clear weather Commence W by N, W by N Lat 06° 00' 59 South Long 139° 53 West
Tuesday May 6 th 1823	All this day light winds and Clear weather the first part Winds from East Commenced N by E at 8 P.M. the wind Shift to S by E Steered W by S in this way Lat 06° 00' 12 South Long 141° 35 West
Wednesday May 7 th 1823	begin with light winds and Clear weather the Sch under all Sail Steering W by N the Middle and latter part Squally with Rain the winds Mostly from S & Commenced S by E Lat 06° 00' 12 South Long 143° 13 West
Thursday May 8 th 1823	begin with light winds from S & E and Clear weather the Sch under all Sail Steering W by N the Middle and latter part Squally Lat 06° 02' 16 South Long 144° 13 West
Friday May 9 th 1823	begin with light winds and Clear weather the Sch under all Sail Steering W by N the Middle and latter part fresh winds and Clear weather to End Lat 06° 03' 55 South Long 146° 09 West
Sat May 10 th 1823	begin with fresh winds and Breezy with Squally weather the Sch under all Sail Steering W by N at 7 P.M. fresh to Squally changed Breezy the Square Sail Broom took in the Sail at the Middle and latter part fresh winds and Steering Sat to 10 to 11 at the Square Sail and I took 3/4 of Sail Lat 06° 05' 45 South Long 148° 59 West
Sunday May 11 th 1823 Green Water	All this 24 hours fresh winds from S & E and Clear weather took in 3/4 of Sail Sprung sail and flying jib till 8 P.M. Double Reefed the Main Sail the latter part Clear Sat the flying jib lowering it W by S to E in this way Lat 06° 04' 59 South Long 150° 39 West
Monday May 12 th 1823 Green Water	All this day fresh winds and Clear weather the Steered Winds Mostly from S & Commenced W by N at 6 to 11 Sat the Square Sail Lat 06° 04' 59 South Long 152° 55 West
Tuesday May 13 th 1823 Green Water	the first part fresh winds from S & E and Clear weather the Middle and latter part more Moderate Made all Sail Commenced W by S to E in this way Lat 06° 11' 55 South Long 155° 33 West
Wednesday May 14 th 1823	All this day fresh winds from S & E and Clear weather Commenced W by N at 6 to 11 Steered West for the Island of Barbados this morning Steered to water Lat 06° 12 53 South Long 157° 53 West

Friday May 15 1823	All the first part Light winds from East the Sch under All S. & under All Sail Steering W by S for the Island of Barbados. At 11 am down took in All Sail But the top sail stood until the day Light Made the Island Bearing West W 10 Leagues Dist. At 11 am the South End Bearing West S by E 10 Leagues Dist. So Ench.
Saturday May 16 1823	All this 24 hours fresh winds from East the Sch under All Sail Cruising off the South End of Barbados. At 11 am down took in All Sail But the top sail stood until the day Light Made the Island Bearing West W 10 Leagues Dist. At 11 am the South End Bearing East 10 Miles the Sch Steering South
Sat May 17 1823	begins with Light winds and Calms the Middle the Sea the South End of St Vincent's N E 15 Miles See the Heads of Small vessels At 8 AM made land and stood to the Northward thick hazy weather and Squally took in flying jib and Double Ruff the Master Sail So Ench this St Lucia Bearing N E by E 20 Miles Dist Wind East S
Sunday May 18 1823	begins with fresh winds from ESE and Squally the Sch under All Sail Steaming to the Southward on the wind At 4 AM Made the Island of Martinico the North End Bearing N E by E Dist 15 Miles the South part light and Calm
Monday May 19 1823	All this day Light winds and Clear weather the Sch under All Sail Cruising off Martinico till 10 AM landed for Provisions So Ench one Boat on Shore
Tuesday May 20 1823	All this day Light winds and Clear weather one Boat on Shore At the Port of St Peter At 6 AM came on board with Sugar Molasses Chocolate &c for the use of the Sch winds Mostly from East Course of W till day light Made the Island of Dominica down the west side of it So Ench this day
Wednesday May 21 1823	till this Light winds and Clear weather the Sch under All Sail Cruising off the South End of Dominica Dist 15 miles the South part Cruising off the East end of the Island of So Ench this day the winds light and variable
Thursday May 22 1823	All this 24 hours Light winds and variable Course North the Island of Monserrat at N W 15 Miles the Sch 2 hours back, So Ench
Friday May 23 1823	All this part of the day Light winds and Clear weather Course South till 10 AM past the Island of Monserrat Bearing West 3 Miles till 10 AM past the North end of Antigua So Ench this day the Sch under All Sail heavy Rain
Sat May 24 1823	All this 24 hours Light winds from East and Clear weather At 4 AM Made the Island of Barbados Bearing N E by E Dist 16 Miles from which Steady N by E Course to the North the Light till 8 AM Steered N W So Ench this day South 6 1/2 18. 24 North Long 62 1/2 West
