

Sat Sept 1st 1827 Begins with fresh winds and squalls
the ship under all sail steering S.W. with the wind S.W.
at 4 P.M. took in top & sails at sundown took over ship in
the top sails at 10 took in jib Main sail Shaker
on I Double reefed the top sails the wind shifted to
W.S.W. and I hove the latter part fresh wind and clear
Sat Obs 29° 49' West

Sunday Sept 2^d 1827 Begins with fresh winds from S.W.
the ship under double reef top sail steering on a wind
to the S.E. Bunt the Main stay sail and fore Mizzen
at 4 A.M. wore ship to S.W. the wind S.E. So ends this
Sat Obs 22° 57' South Long 29° 16' West

Monday Sept 3^d 1827 Begins with fresh winds from S.E.
and squally the ship under double reef top sails and
courses steering S.W. at 4 P.M. bunt the fore
top sails and I bunt the latter part the wind
turned the keels out so ends the day
Sat Obs 23° 52' South Long 30° 37' West

Tuesday Sept 4th 1827 All this 24 hours fresh winds
from S.E. and squally the ship under reef
top sails and courses at 6 A.M. furl the Main sail
and down the Mizzen top gable and yard and Mast
and stored them away so ends the day
Sat Obs 25° 58' South Long 32° 15' West

Wednesday Sept 5th 1827 Begins with fresh winds
from S.E. and squally the ship under double
reef top sails fore sail and stay sails steering
S.W. at 4 P.M. close reef the top sails
the latter part the wind changed much all sail
so ends fresh weather in company with the 9 Porter
Sat Obs 28° 11' South Long 33° 55' West

Thursday Sept 6th 1827 All this 24 hours light winds
and clear weather the ship under all sail steering
S.W. the first part the wind S.E. the Middle and latter
part South Sea hump back and for back so ends
took in the mast boat and painted her
Sat Obs 29° 18' South Long 35° 01' West

Friday Sept 7th 1827 Begins with light winds from
S.W. and clear weather the ship under all sail steering
S.W. at 4 A.M. took in Main top sail and fore sail
steering sail fresh winds at 8 P.M. in jib Main
sail and I Double reefed the top sails so ends
Sat Obs 31° 18' South Long 37° 39' West

Sat Sept 8th 1827 Begins with fresh winds from S.W.
and clear weather the ship under double reef top sails
steering steering S.W. at 4 P.M. took in the Mizzen
top sail close reef the fore and Main at 10 took
in the fore top sail blowing at gale at 1 P.M. the
wind shifted to S.W. and Moral I set at 2 Set the
fore and Mizzen top sail at 3 A.M. turned over the out
of each top sail so ends heading S.E. the wind S.W.
Sat Obs 32° 24' South Long 37° 54' West Sea hump back

Sunday Sept 9th 1827 Begins with fresh winds from S.W.
the ship under double reef top sails standing on a
wind to W.S.W. at 6 P.M. wore ship to S.E.
the Middle the lower the latter part the wind fresh
Sat Obs 33° 03' South Long 37° 48' West

Monday Sept 10th 1827 Begins with fresh gales from West
the ship under double reef top sails at standing on a wind
to S.W. at 4 P.M. close reef the top sails
the Middle and latter part the same
Sat Obs 34° 07' South Long 36° 49' West

Tuesday Sept 11th 1827 Begins with fresh gales
from S.W. the ship to W.S.W. under close reef
top sails the Middle Mordred turned over the out
of each top sail the wind S.W. the latter the same
Sat Obs 33° 51' South Long 35° 13' West

Wednesday Sept 12th 1827 Begins with fresh gales from
S.E. the ship under double reef top sails steering
S.W. the Middle the wind hauled to S.E. and
Monday at 1 Mach all sail so ends this day Sea hump back
Sat Obs 34° 38' South Long 40° 16' West

Thursday Sept 13th 1827 Begins with fresh gales from
S.E. the ship under all sail steering S.W. at
at sundown Double reefed the top sails at 2 P.M.
bunt the Mizzen top sails at 10 took in the fore
and close reef the Main at 2 A.M. took in the
Went 13 out and hove to heading W.S.W. the wind South
at 6 A.M. set the fore sail and fore top sail and stand
S.W. the latter part the wind S.W. and so ends fresh
gales and squally
Sat Obs 36° 10' South Long 42° 36' West
