

Sat July 5th 1828 Began with fresh winds from
N. E. and E. N. E. with the ship under all
Sail standing to the Southward the M. d. n.
Light winds from N. E. & E. N. E. and stood
to the westward at 6 o'clock an English Brig
schooner from London bound to England at 7 o'clock
A schooner from Boston bound to London this day
Lat 40. 09. 00 Long 70. 15. 00
Sounded and found 70 fathoms
Black and White Sand

Sunday July 6th 1828 Commenced with
fresh winds and clear weather the
ship under all sail standing to the
S. by E. at 6 A. M. Made the Land which
appeared to be Black Island
at 10 took the Pilot Gay head bearing
N. East at noon got in
O. R.
