at 10.00 saw ship bearing E we
made and shortened sail at 10.00
at 10.00 these 24 hour Sat 9.40.00

Sunday Sept the 21st 1895 Day 15
All this 24 hour strong wind from the
N.W. & have sent sail at 10.00
implored the waves took ship duty a man
at the mast head to look for whales
at 10.00 Sat 9.40.00 Long 14.00

Tuesday the 22nd 1895
the worst part of this 24 hour strong
wind, mild and better tonight
all hands in place at duty 10.00
at 10.00 Sat 9.40.00 Long 14.00

Friday Sept the 25th 1895
this day pleasant weather and at 10.00
saw the crew implored the ship duty
made and shortened sail at 10.00
at 10.00 saw a long steaming
ship and several other ships in sight
at 10.00 Sat 9.40.00 Long 14.00

Saturday September the 26th 1895
this day pleasant weather with a
breeze from the westward we
are under full sail the watch in place
at 10.00 duty hitting boats and shorted
saw several whales all hands at the
mast head ship long and shorted
at 10.00 this day Sat 9.40.00 Long 14.00

Sunday Sept the 27th 1895
this day pleasant weather and at 10.00
saw the crew from the 3rd course plain by &
under full sail saw several whales
at 10.00 Sat 9.40.00 Long 14.00
