this day pleasant the land breeze from the N.W. & light breeze from the S.W. saw whales in the lead & boats and sheeps returned with no whales at 11 too a few miles from the ice drove us up to the N. out of sight of the land under short sail saw several seals  
So ends this day with a gale 43

October the 21<sup>st</sup> 1895

this day very disagreeable foggy thick mist the S.W. wind very large whales lead & boats the mast boat struck a large whale got the in it several lost the whale line and all  
So ends this day with a hard gale 44

October the 22<sup>nd</sup> 1895

this day a gale of wind and a heavy sea under short sail so ends 45

October the 23<sup>rd</sup> 1895

this day pleasant weather and light winds from the N.W. N.W. by the wind to the S. and in under easy sail saw a long steaming  
So ends this day 46

October the 24<sup>th</sup> 1895

this day a gale from the S.W. steered to the N. by the wind under short sail all hands on deck saw the land at 11  
At 11 landed at 12 light breeze  
So ends this day 47
