Steamer and ship at 6 o'clock M. Spoke the
Shagell of N. Begill and

Friday November the 20th 1835
this day pleasant weather with the
winds from the E and S. in company
with the Shagell the captain of
her came on board at 6 o'clock and returned
on board of his own ship with hands in
place at 8 o'clock. Putting up the rig
So ends this day 68

Saturday November the 21st 1835
this day pleasant weather with strong
breeze from the E & S. Steam at 8 o'clock
at 10 o'clock M. Spoke the English Man-of-war
bound to the westward
So ends this day 69

Sunday November the 22nd 1835
this day pleasant weather. The fine gales
from the E & S. Steam at 8 o'clock by the
by the wind at 3 o'clock M. And light till
6 o'clock M. the under short sail at 6 o'clock
we saw a long of war in shape of us. At
