gales and so forth  
So ends this day Lat 49.10 S Long 89.10 118

Saturday January the 9th 1896  
this day strong winds from the N. W. Cape  
steard & E under all sail the watch  
in flood it saw many gales  
So ends this day Lat 49.10 S Long 88.10 119

Sunday January the 10th 1896  
this day strong winds from the N. W. Cape  
& E under all sail at 9 a.m. saw a  
shale of whalers boat & boats the 1st  
boat was the watch the steard and boat got  
the chase started at 2 whalers and did  
not fasten and returned  
So ends this day Lat 49.10 S Long 87.10 120

Monday January the 11th 1896  
this day strong gales from the N. W. Cape  
steard & E under all sail the watch  
in flood it making spurs and the compass  
repairing the log went  
So ends this day Lat 49.10 S Long 86.10 121
