Friday February the 12th 1896
this Day a severe gale from the SSE
the crew implew it wares ship. Sevil
nearly came in
so ends this Day

Saturday February the 13th 1896
this Day we getting ready to go to sea
6 p.m. the ship took her home short on the
Lantern Chain sent her and Main top
galant Mast and Main top galant
yard and the home top sail lay stowing
her to her. At 11 p.m. the boat came
on board

so ends this Day
Sunday February the 14th 1896
this Day we the boat to sea in company
with the China and Marsha both
of which had at 1 p.m. took our anchor
and made sail the wind was light
and to the eastward into the S. E. wind
then took it strong wind and till we
got to the N. of the island there
it was calm took anchor on the ground

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we bent the anchor. Stead then it was
the later part light winds and
warmed so ends this Day

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Monday February the 15th 1896
this Day strong winds from the SSE steamed
by the wind to the N. E. the Mar. ship
and China in company so ends

Tuesday February the 16th 1896
this Day a gale of wind from the
S. E. heaved to the sea our compass in camp
it had sea on the ship pitched it
about but is quite stiff to what she
was the ship is in company and
the ship pass to the windward bound in
so ends this Day

Wednesday February the 17th 1896
this Day strong winds from the S. E. steamed
by the wind wind to the S. W. in company
with the China and Coisa under short
sail so ends this Day Lat 99.17 Long

159

Thursday February the 18th 1896
this Day light winds and pleasant
weather the China in company coast
off the Coisa steamed by the wind
to the S. W. under intercal sail at 4 p.m.
the Captain of the China came on board us

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Friday February the 19th 1896
this Day light winds from the S. E. steamed
Coisa steamed S. E. by the China in company
under full sail so ends this Day

Saturday February the 20th 1896
this Day strong winds from the S. E.
shortened sail it was only
so ends this Day

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
