at 11 all hands in place at anchoring etc  
saw 1 thin hawk  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 919

Sunday July the 31<sup>st</sup> 1896  
this day light wind and braced at 6 p M  
shortened sail at 6 p M shortened sail  
saw 1 thin hawk  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 914

Monday August the 1<sup>st</sup> 1896  
this day burst part light winds and present  
Mild and later part increasing gales  
and raged at 6 p M shortened sail at 11  
more ship to the S at 11 made sail and  
steard S & the watch in place at anchored  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 915

Tuesday August the 2<sup>nd</sup> 1896  
this day strong breeze with thick overcast  
weather plenty rain steard to the N at 4  
at 11 more to the S wind from the S lay  
under short sail at 11 ship passed us to  
the windward saw nothing worth notice  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 916

Wednesday July the 31<sup>st</sup> 1896  
this day strong winds from the  
S with rain squalls thick overcast  
sky steard to the S at 11 more  
ship to the N saw nothing of  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 917

Thursday August the 4<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather plenty of thin  
haws steard to the S at 11 more to the  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 918

Friday August the 4<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day squally weather saw nothing worth  
notice at 6 p M shortened sail at 11  
made sail steard to the S at 11 more to  
to the N wind from the S the watch in  
place at mending sails  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 919

Saturday August the 6<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day strong breeze from the S & steard  
saw 1 thin hawk the watch in place at  
mending sails at 6 p M shortened sail at  
6 p M made sail  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 920

Sunday August the 7<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day strong winds from the S & S  
steard S 1/4 W saw nothing worth notice  
at 6 p M shortened sail at 11  
made sail  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 921

Monday August the 9<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day strong winds from the N & S  
with a thick overcast sky shower  
of rain at 6 p M shortened sail at 11  
at 11 got a close-ribbed <sup>five</sup> main top sail  
and steard by the wind to the S & S  
at 11 more to the N & S  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 922

Tuesday August the 9<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day light winds from the N steard  
N & S under such sail as we saw fit  
saw nothing worth mentioning  
the watch in place at wares etc  
So ends this day Satt 25.10 Song 184.10 923
