

Wednesday August the 10th 1896
this day pin lines from the E Stead 1/2
saw several pin backs at 4 P M shortened
sail at 4 P M made sail the water in place
at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 25.00 Long 189.100 324

Thursday August the 11th 1896
the burst and midel part light winds
from the E at 10 P M the wind moved
to it all with rain at 9 P M saw
several pin backs and 1 sperm whale
boarded boats the Sperm whale struck
the whale got head line and captured
and lost the whale and line
then returned to the ship
So ends this day Satt 25.90 Long 189.110 325

Friday August the 12th 1896
this day strong gales from the W with
torrents of rain squalls of rain lay
by the wind to the N at 6 P M more
to the S 1 ship to the windward 2 to
the leeward the watch in place at
noon. So ends this day Satt 25.40 Long 189.140 326

Saturday August the 13th 1896
this day a gale from the W lay by
the wind to the S under it at 10 P M
left main top sail and stay sales
at 4 P M spoke the whale went 1/2
of bare hansen 91 Monts out 2000 lbs of
oil this day ends with gales and squalls
of rain and a high sea the
ship laboring very heavy at 6 P M
more to the N at 11 P M

Saw nothing worth notice
So ends this day Satt 25.40 Long 189.150 327

Sunday August the 14th 1896
the burst part strong gales from the E at
the midel and later part pleasant weather
at 9 P M made sail saw 1 ship to the leeward
stood to the N saw nothing worth notice
So ends this day Satt 25.20 Long 189.110 328

Monday August the 15th 1896
this day pleasant weather with a light breeze
from the S E Stead Sails by the wind
at 7 P M more to the N E saw nothing
the watch in place at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 25.30 Long 189.110 329

Tuesday August the 16th 1896
this day pleasant weather at 6 P M
shortened sail at 4 P M made sail and
steamed N E at 9 P M tacked to the
S wind E S E at 10 P M saw 1 pin back
and a whole of black fish the watch
in place at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 25.50 Long 189.110 330

Wednesday August the 17th 1896
this day pleasant weather wind from the
S E Stead to the S at 8 P M more to the N E
saw 2 ships at 11 P M spoke the
Mexican Cophin 27 Monts out 900 lbs
of oil the watch in place at mending
sails saw nothing
So ends this day Satt 25.99 Long 189.140 331

Thursday August the 18th 1896
this day pleasant weather wind from the
S E Stead to the S at 4 P M more to the
N E saw 2 ships to the leeward saw
several pin backs the watch in
place at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 25.50 Long 189.150 332
