

Friday August the 19th 1896
this day part pleasant weather
Midel And later part a gale from
the S & saw several ships saw nothing
worth notice about the ship by
the wind to the south under a close
reft to main top sail and stay sails
So ends this day Lat 24° 10' Long 184° 10' 939

Saturday August the 20th 1896
this day a strong gale from the S &
lay by the S till 4 PM more to the S &
saw 1 ship to the windward we have some
rain squally
So ends this day Lat 26° 11' Long 183° 11' 940

Sunday August the 21st 1896
this day a gale from the S & lay by the
wind to the S till 4 PM got the fore sail
And main stay sail saw nothing worth
So ends this day Lat 26° 12' Long 183° 11' 941

Monday August the 22nd 1896
this day a gale from the S & blowing heavy
at 4 PM more to the S till 9 PM more ship to
the S & under the main top sail &
And stay sails saw nothing worth notice
So ends this day Lat 25° 30' Long 183° 11' 942

Tuesday August the 23rd 1896
this day a strong gale from the S & steamed
to the N & saw nothing but a gale of
wind and I had see us there under short sail
So ends this day Lat 24° 50' Long 183° 11' 943

Wednesday August the 24th 1896
this day a gale of wind from the S &
saw nothing worth notice we were under short
sail heaved to the N &
So ends this day Lat 25° 00' Long 183° 40' 944

Thursday August the 25th 1896
this day a gale from the S & to the S &
under short sail saw nothing worth notice
So ends this day Lat 25° 10' Long 183° 11' 945

Friday August the 26th 1896
this day a gale from the S & steamed to the
N & at 4 PM got the fore top sail & lost
reft saw nothing worth notice
So ends this day Lat 25° 10' Long 183° 11' 946

Saturday August the 27th 1896
this day a heavy sea & squally weather wind
from the S & till more ship to the S & under
short sail at 3 PM took in the fore top sail
saw nothing worth mention
So ends this day Lat 25° 30' Long 183° 11' 947

Sunday August the 28th 1896
the first part the wind blew heavy
and a heavy sea the middle and latter
part a moder breeze with squalls of rain
at 1 PM more ship to the N & at 4 PM
got the fore top sail and main sail
So ends this day Lat 25° 10' Long 183° 11' 948

Monday August the 29th 1896
this day squally weather wind from the S &
steamed N & at 4 PM shortened sail
at 10 PM made sail and on bent the
silk and bent a new one saw nothing
the watch in flood at 11 PM
So ends this day Lat 24° 11' Long 184° 11' 949

Tuesday August the 30th 1896
this day pleasant weather wind from the
S & steamed N & under all sail
saw nothing worth notice the watch in flood
waves fresh So ends this day Lat 29° 35' Long 184° 11' 950
