


Friday September the 9<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather saw nothing  
worth the notice made and shortened sail  
at 6 p.m. so  
So ends this day Lat 24° 00' Long 189° 54'

Saturday September the 10<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather at 4 p.m. saw a large  
whale board with company with the 6  
schooners boats we got the whale at 6  
p.m. took the whale a long side and  
shortened sail at 6 p.m. commenced cutting  
saw some fin hawks  
So ends this day Lat 25° 10' Long  95°


Sunday September the 11<sup>th</sup> 1896  
the first part of this day pleasant at 9 p.m.  
got three cutting were ship to the 14<sup>th</sup>  
harque & in company the mid and later part  
squalls of rain with light winds at 4 p.m.  
began to hail at 4 p.m. cooled down the  
works by rain lost site site sight of  
our partner in the night we are under our  
fore sail and lost next main and stay sails  
So ends this day Lat 25° 30' Long 189° 30' E 95°

Monday the 12<sup>th</sup> September 1896  
all this day pleasant weather with light  
winds from the W we are in plain, at hailing  
led to the S & under it light press of sail  
saw black fish board the harbor boat  
got nothing returned to the ship at meridian  
So ends this day Lat 26° 09' Long 189° 10' E 95°

Tuesday September the 13<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather light winds wind  
and waves saw nothing worth notice led  
to the E and short sail we are in plain at  
hailing so ends this day Lat 26° 00' Long 189° 00' E 95°

Wednesday September the 14<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather and light winds from  
the N steered E at 4 p.m. got three hailing  
at 6 p.m. shortened sail and left to the wind  
at 6 p.m. made sail and steered E saw some  
horses so  
So ends this day Lat 25° 44' Long 189° 30' E 95°

Thursday September the 15<sup>th</sup> 1896  
all this day squally hard looking weather with  
strong from the S & steered E saw long  
quantity of birds the watch in plain at  
waves of fish  
So ends this day Lat 25° 11' Long 189° 11' E 96°

Friday September the 16<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day commenced with strong winds from the  
E & S and ends with a gale at 4 p.m. saw  
a whole of whales to the windward 4 miles  
at 6 p.m. shortened sail and haled by  
the wind to the N at 6 p.m. more ship  
to the S & saw squalls of rain   
So ends this day Lat 25° 00' Long 189° 30' E 96°

Saturday September the 17<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather at 6 p.m. saw  
several hawks 5 miles off at 4 p.m. commenced  
coopering the oil at 8 p.m. got the fore top  
sail and haled.  
So ends this day Lat 25° 30' Long 189° 14' E 96°

Sunday September the 18<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather at 6 p.m. made sail  
and steered E saw nothing worth notice  
So ends this day Lat 25° 29' Long 189° 50' E 96°

Monday September the 19<sup>th</sup> 1896  
this day pleasant weather wind N steered E  
at 6 p.m. commenced stowing down under short  
sail so ends this day Lat 25° 00' Long 189° 10' E 96°
