So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 965

Wednesday September the 21st 1896
this day light winds from the NE and present
weather steered E saw nothing worth notice
back of shore the sea is very smooth in deed
the watch were employed at various jobs
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 966

Thursday September the 22nd 1896
this day light winds and present weather saw nothing
worth notice at 6 p.m. shortened sail at 4 p.m.
made sail and steered ESE the watch
employed at slackening the iron work
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 967

Friday September the 23rd 1896
this day strong winds from the NNE steered ESE
thick over cast weather at 6 p.m. shortened
sail at 6 p.m. made sail and steered ESE
saw nothing worth notice
So ends this day Satt 24.1.96 968

Saturday September the 24th 1896
this day strong winds from the NNE at 6 p.m.
shortened sail at 4 p.m. made sail at 6 p.m.
saw a large whal load the boat the barboard
boat struck the whal and damaged the iron
returned to the ship at 11 p.m.
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 969

Sunday September the 25th 1896
this day strong winds from the ESE
thick and shortened sail at 6 p.m. repaired
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 Long 970

Monday September the 26th 1896
this day a gale from the ESE by the wind
to the NNE at 11 p.m. more ship to the NNE under
short sail at 4 p.m. saw a whale of black
bribe
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 971

Tuesday September the 27th 1896
this day a gale from the ESE with torrents
of rain lay by the wind to the ESE
at 11 p.m. more to the NNE under short
sail at 6 p.m. next main top sail 392
and stay sail
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 Long 972

Wednesday September the 28th 1896
this day light winds from the NNE steered
E at 4 p.m. made sail saw a fish hook
the watch employed at various jobs
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 Long 973

Thursday September the 29th 1896
this day light winds from the NNE with
sun rain and smooth sea saw nothing worth
notice the watch employed at various jobs
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 Long 974

Friday September the 30th 1896
this day present weather and light winds from
the NNE steered E saw nothing worth notice
the watch employed at mending sails at
11 p.m. bent the main top sail and bent
a mether So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 Long 975

Saturday October the 1st 1896
this day present weather winds from the
NNE steered E saw sun portages at 6 p.m.
shortened sail at 6 p.m. made sail the watch
employed at mending sails
So ends this day Satt 25.1.96 Long 976
