this day present weather and light wind from
the N^W & N^E steered E at 4 p.m. ^{shoreward} made sail
at 5 p.m. made sail saw plenty of birds.
So ends this day Lat 21.94 Long 16 944

Monday October the 3^d 1896
this day present weather light wind from
the west at 4 p.m. saw the island of ~~St. Thomas~~
bore & desert of 9 leagues calm so 948
So ends this day Lat 21.59 Long

Tuesday October the 4th 1896
this day light wind from the S^W
with present weather steered E & N
under all sail at 6 p.m. the land bore
N^W 1/2 N by compass dist 8 leagues 949
So ends this day Lat 21.40

Wednesday October the 5th 1896
this day light winds and calm with
present weather steered in until 11 p.m.
then tacked up till 9 then tacked in
So ends this day 950

Thursday October the 6th 1896
this day present weather at 6 p.m. a
boat came from the shore it long since
of it all the boat went to shore 2 of our
boats were employed in getting of our
recutes 951
So ends this day

Friday October the 7th 1896
this day first part present weather at
4 p.m. the boats returned to the ship
with a load of hogs and potatoes the middle
and latter part strong gales and clouds
of rain wind N^W 1/2 N we drifted to the
leeward 20 miles So ends this day 952

Saturday October the 8th 1896 N^W 1/2 N
this day first part strong wind and squally
weather and later part calm
the land bore N^W 1/2 N distant 4 leagues
at 11 p.m. 953
So ends this day

Sunday October the 9th 1896
this day strong gales and squally weather
with plenty of rain at 11 p.m. the land
bore N^W 1/2 N dist 9 leagues 954
So ends this day

Monday October the 10th 1896
this day strong winds at 9 p.m. the boat
went to shore and returned at 4 p.m. spoke
the Calmar 60 lbs of oil at 9 p.m. the boat
went to shore at 11 p.m. the boat returned
with a load of potatoes and fruit 955
So ends this day

Tuesday October the 11th 1896
this day first part present weather the boat
went to shore at 4 p.m. at 4 p.m. they returned
the latter part squally got aboard of
boat all day and could not get up with
land so ends this day 956

Wednesday October the 12th 1896
this day strong winds and squally weather
but this day and could not get up with
the land so ends this day 957

Thursday October the 13th 1896
Thursday this day strong winds and rained with
thick squally rainy weather sudden shifts of wind
So ends this day at 11 p.m. the land bore dist
958

Friday October the 14th 1896
this day strong gales the tide was very strong
could not get up with the land so ends 959
