the first part light winds and calm
the mid and later part strong winds
from the S E and S W under all sail
So Ends this day Lat 24.10 Long 166.10ⁱⁿ

Saturday October the 29th 1896
this day strong winds from the S E Stead
at 4 p M saw a long whale
it being late did not load shortened sail
and heaved to the S by the wind at 11 p M
more to the N at 10 p M more to the S and
made sail last bit of the Enchelarⁱⁿ
So Ends this day Lat 24.19 Long 168.11ⁱⁿ

Sunday October the 30th 1896
this day strong gale from the S E Stead
at 4 p M under all press of sail at 4 p M
shortened sail at 4 p M made sailⁱⁿ
So Ends this day Lat 25.19 Long 170.30ⁱⁿ

Monday October the 31st 1896 Long 1
this day strong gales from S E lay by
the wind heaved to the S under all press
Main top sail and fore sail and stay
sails So Ends this day Lat 25.17 Long 171.10ⁱⁿ

Tuesday November the 1st 1896
this day Mad with breezes from the S E at 4
p M made sail saw a whale of black
high Stead to the S W
So Ends this day Lat 26.19 Long 172.05ⁱⁿ

Wednesday October the 2nd 1896
this day light winds and calm and laid
and shortened sail and hoisted
saw nothing worth notice
the watch impled at 11 p M
So Ends this day Lat 27.10 Long 173.30ⁱⁿ

Thursday November the 3rd 1896
this day light wind from the S E
stead to the west made and shortened
sail at 6 p M at 9 p M sent up the fore
top galant mast saw nothing
So Ends this day Lat 27.10 Long 174.30ⁱⁿ

Friday November the 4th 1896
this day light winds from the S E Stead at 4 p M
under all sail saw nothing worth notice the watch
impled at 11 p M
So Ends this day Lat 27.40 Long 174.11ⁱⁿ

Saturday November the 5th 1896
this day strong winds from the S E Stead at 4 p M
short sail thick rainy weather saw plenty of birds
So Ends this day Lat 26.10 Long 174.11ⁱⁿ

Sunday November the 6th 1896
this day strong wind from the S E with
squalls of rain Stead to the N at 4 p M
saw a whale of black saw and
got a the waist boat and Lashin boatⁱⁿ
So Ends this day Lat 25.10 Long 174.20ⁱⁿ
412

Monday November the 7th 1896
this day strong gales from the S E at 4 p M
commenced cutting at 5 p M commenced hauling
So Ends this day Lat 24.30 Long 175.10ⁱⁿ
413

Tuesday November the 8th 1896
this day strong winds from the S E we lay by
the wind to the S under short sail and hoisting
at 4 p M saw a long whale bound to the
Westward at 2 in the after upon the waist
boat stowed the whale and got him and
took the whale to the ship and ship to
the land So Ends this day Lat 25.10 Long 175.30ⁱⁿ
