So Ends this day Satt 25.90 Long 144.49 484

Thursday November the 10th 1896

The first part present weather mild and calm
part squally weather wind shifted from E to
SE at 4 P.M. got them battering at 5.
M commenced hoisting under short sail headed to
the S. So Ends this day Satt 25.90 Long 144.90 415

Friday November the 11th 1896

This day present weather we are implead at hauling
saw a vessel to the windward under from the ESE
So Ends this day Satt 25.90 Long 144.90 416

Saturday November the 12th 1896

This day present weather at 4 P.M. strike the long
narrow hull 6 taken 10 Monts from syring 500 lbs of
oil and 1 long whale at long side the larynge ship
normal up of sound in Capt line 10 Monts 900 lbs of
oil at 9 P.M. got them hauling under from the E
So Ends this day Satt 24.40 Long 149.10 417

Sunday November the 13th 1896

This day strong winds from the ESE saw nothing
worth notice steared to the S under short sail
So Ends this day Satt 25.80 Long 149.90 418

Monday November the 14th 1896

This day strong winds saw nothing worth mention
at 7 P.M. began to sto down under short sail
So Ends this day Satt 24.49 Long 149.25 419

Tuesday November the 15th 1896

This day saw nothing we are implead at strong
saw a vessel at 4 P.M. got them stoing down
So Ends this day Satt 24.47 Long 149.48 420

Wednesday November the 16th 1896

This day present weather wind from the ESE
ste to the N under short sail at 4 P.M. more
sail and wore ship to the S still hands in plaid
at washing ship saw nothing worth notice
So Ends this day Satt 25.09 Long 149.58 421

Thursday November the 17th 1896

The first part of this day strong winds
the wind and latter part light wind and
calm saw nothing worth notice
So Ends this day Satt 26.10 Long 144.08 422

Friday

Wednesday November the 18th 1896

The first and mild present weather later
squally weather with some rain saw her passes
steared to the S under short sail
So Ends this day Satt 25.49 Long 144.90 423

Saturday November the 19th 1896

This day strong winds and warched the first part
rain in torrents. Sheer sail to it close next
Main top sail at 4 P.M. sat the fore top sail
and filled the Hatch implead at warched
saw saw nothing worth notice
So Ends this day Satt 25.48 Long 144.20 424

Sunday November the 20th 1896

This day strong winds from the ESE steared to the
N at 1 P.M. more to the S and made sail at 10
P.M. up of S under all sail
So Ends this day Satt 25.10 Long 144.58 425

Monday November the 21st 1896

This day strong winds from the ESE steared to
the N at 1 P.M. more ship to the S at 1 P.M. all
saw several large whales and 3 shoals of
whales and did not strike returned
So Ends this day Satt 25.11 Long 145.11 426
